I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Was this device tested as a Computer Peripheral? If so, then either Certification under Part 15B or Declaration of Conformity with the associated inclusion of FCC logo on the label would apply. Please review and correct.
- 2.) The Block Diagram does not conform to the requirements of 2.1033(b). Kindly correct showing signal paths, oscillators and their frequencies.
- 3.) For this Test Setup, a complete radiated description conforming to ANSI C63.4 should be used. This typically includes a printer, mouse, external monitor, etc. Please review.
- 4.) The claimed RF Pout of 19mW combined with the antenna gain as published in Section 14 of the Test Report requires the addition of SAR test results to this filing. All transmitting devices sold to the general public where a minimum 2.5cm separation distance cannot be maintained between the device and all persons will be required to supply SAR test results when either their radiated or conducted power exceeds 60mW/f(GHz). For 2.4GHz devices this translates to 24mW. Your radiated EIRP exceeds +18dBm. Please review.
