

Smart Phone Function

1. Refer to "Enter Pairing Mode" to pair Nighthawk to your smart phone.

2. Activate phone in pairing mode. When the word Nighthawk appears, connect to that device. You may need to enter a code "0000" to Pair.

Volume Control

1. Long-press the "+" to increase volume and the "-" button to decrease volume.

Phone Application

1. In incoming phone call state, short-press the MFB button to answer the phone call.

2. In incoming phone call state, double MFB button to reject the phone call.

3. In phone call active state, short press MFB button to hang up the phone call.

4. In cell phone connected state, double press the MFB button can dial the latest dialed out number.

Audio File Application

1. Refer to "Enter Pairing Mode" to pair Nighthawk to your audio device.

2. In music playing state, short-press the MFB button to Play / Pause music.

3. In music playing state, short-press the "+" to skip track forward & short-press the "-" button to skip track backward.

Volume Control Side Note:

1. You may want to increase the volume on the Nighthawk before pairing to music device, volume button doubles as track function.

Charging:

1. It is recommended to charge Nighthawk after 10 to 12 hours of use. The first indicator of low battery is when no sound is coming through the earpiece.

2. To charge, "Power Off" Nighthawk, connect mini USB cable to Nighthawk USB port. Connect opposite end to computer or wall charger. Flashing RED light will appear. Light will turn solid RED once the unit is fully charged.

3. Charge time: 2-3 hours.

LED Indication

Off/On: Blue, two

Idle: Blue slow

Pairing: Red, blue

PTT pressed: Red on

PTT released: Red off

Charging: Flashing Red

Fully Charged: Solid Red

Battery Low: Red slow

NIGHTHAWK PERFORMANCE TIPS

Reducing white/static noise: Reduce the volume on the Nighthawk unit & increase the volume on the radio. This will reduce white noise.

Reducing wind noise: The Nighthawk microphone is very sensitive. Wear the Nighthawk inside garment or under a jacket. This will shield outside elements.



Earpiece installation

To secure the earpiece from separating from the microphone, after connecting the earpiece to the jack, wrap the cable though the microphone clip then attach to the garment.



Lanyard usage



Wearing the lanyard will prevent the Nighthawk from coming off the body. First, pass the lanyard through the microphone clip. Pull on it to make sure the fit is snug. Then clip the claw through the button hole.

To Power On / Off:

Power On: Press the MFB button for 1 second & release, will power on Bluetooth system.

Power Off: Long-press the MFB button for 6 second & release.

To Enter Pairing Mode for Radio Use:

1. During "Power Off" state, press & hold down the MFB button for more than 8 seconds, until the RED LED & BLUE LED enter a flashing state, then release the MFB button.

To Enter Pairing Mode for Radio Use, Continued...

2. Attach Bluetooth radio adapter to radio. Press and hold pairing/PTT button and turn on the radio at the same time. Do not release the button until you see two blue pulses at one time. Release after the two pulses. Hold Nighthawk close to radio. When the light on the Nighthawk and the radio adapter are solid blue, the two units are paired. You can transmit from the PTT button on the Nighthawk as well as the PTT button on the Bluetooth adapter.
