I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Please identify the person signing the Confidentiality Request letter. Who is Cota Tsai and under what authority does she speak on behalf of E-Ten Systems?
- 2.) FYI: The label has the following language: "Use appropriately for effect of electromagnetic wave". This will not have any meaning to native English speakers. You may wish to rephrase this sentence.
- 3.) Please provide a detailed block diagram of the Bluetooth device.
- 4.) Please provide a detailed block diagram of the WLAN device.
- 5.) It appears this device can utilize the SKYPE service. If so, I would expect that when working in WiFi mode, it can receive voice communications. Please explain why no head SAR is included for the 2450 MHz band.
- 6.) I note in the Manual that the wireless manager appears to be capable of an "All On" condition where Bluetooth, WiFi and GSM are all transmitting simultaneously. This appears contrary to the "no co-location" attestation you have submitted. Please explain in detail.
- 7.) Unless I am mistaken, the EMC report is showing a higher RF conducted power for the 850MHz band than the SAR report. This is not allowed. Please correct and retest if needed.
