

## Functions:

- 1 To learn the numbers on the characters.
- 2 To learn the different colours.
- 3 Six different sounds.
- 4 To learn how to count total quantities of characters.
- 5 To learn six different characters.
- 6 Follow the instructions to put the character on the meadow.

## Suggestions:

- After removing a character from the farm, wait until you hear the sentence from the farm before replacing it.
- If the farm fails to recognise the characters, or recognises them incorrectly, insert new batteries.
- Use and store the Magic Farm in room temperature environment.

## Important:

- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before recharging.
- Recharge rechargeable batteries only under adult supervision.
- Non rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short circuited.
- Remove all the batteries when the toy is not in use for a long time.
