I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments. FYI: I urge you to carefully review the requirements of FCC for Amplifiers, Boosters and Repeaters published by FCC in April, 2007.

- 1.) Please refer to FCC KDB publication 935210 for amplifiers, boosters and repeaters. Please refer to page 3 [Reminder Sheet]. Does this device more closely resemble the description of a Booster or Repeater?
- 2.) Please provide an attestation or letter from the applicant acknowledging their understanding of the criteria for boosters set forth in 90.219.
- 3.) Please confirm that only one type of modulation [GXW] will be used in this device. What will happen if another type of modulation is seen by the donor antenna?
- 4.) Please provide some justification for the input signals used. Publication 935210 requests plots of both input and output signals.
- 5.) Please confirm if this is designed to be a single-channel system or not. If multi-channel, then intermodulation tests will be required.
- 6.) Please confirm the output power testing with regard to input drive and saturation requested in Publication 935210.
- 7.) Please be sure that all plots will have masks applied as appropriate for Part 90.
