I. Characteristic:

III. Handle method:

- 1. Take PS/PS2 CD to PS/PS2 host computer.
- 2. Switch on power supply
- 3. Cased 2 batteries (AAA) to Game pad.
- 4. Connect the signal to host computer that the RX1 in Host flicker.
- 5. Debugging the same channel on Gamepad & Host.
- $6.\, \text{Then}$ the MODE LED & RX1 LED bright that show could use.

IV. Function use method:

I) MODE LED:

Digital/Analog: Separate by Orange and Green.

Every press the ANALOG that the MODE change, From Digital → Analog→ Digital…circle.

II) RX1 LED:

- 1. Handle: Debugging the same channel on Gamepad & Host.
- 2. Direction: Normality: The light shine

Abnormality: The Light flicker

3. Explain: At the same host area more than 20 players, reverse could not circulate.

Ⅲ) Sleeping & Awaken:

- 1. Action: For saving. (current < 2mA)
- 2. Explain: The light flicker for host at rest 3 minutes. Take the START button it restart.

IV) Replace button:

- 1. Handle: The 2 rockers on left and right express Bearing on Digital MODE.
- 2. Direction: N/A
- 3. Explain: For player to handle bearing expediently on Digital MODE.

V. WARNING:

- 1. Do not submerge in water.
- 2. Do not disassociate any part of Gamepad & Host
- 3. Do not place heavy objects on top of Gamepad & Host
- 4. Do not allow small children to play with Gamepad & Host unsupervised.
- 5. Do not use this controller in any other way than its intended use.

- 7. Keep away from areas where dirt or liquid can get into Gamepad & Host
