Notice

1. Do turn off power switch after running it, if not, electric energy will be exhausted bit and working time would be shortened.

Frequency & Location

- 1. If there are cars of same frequency running around, the car may be uncontrolled.
- 2. And, if interfered by other electric waves, the car may also be uncontrollable. Try changing the playing location or run it at later time.
- 3. Rough cement ground is suitable for the car running. Running on water milled cement ground or on even smoother ground may cause malfunctions such as off-course running, tossing at 180° or spinning at the same place for there is too little friction between the wheel and the ground surface.
- 4. The playfield should be large enough. It is not suggested to run inside family house.

Installation and Replacement of Battery in Controller

- 1. Use a screwdriver to unscrew the screws of the cover on the back of the remote controller. Press the button and take down the cover.
- 2. Put 2x1.5V AA cell into it.
- 3. If the buttons don't work effectively or the indicating light becomes dim, renew the battery.

Installation and Replacement of Batteries in Car Body

- 1. Make sure the power switch at the rear of the car is at OFF position, then unscrew the battery cover and slide it to one side to open it.
- 2. After loading 4x1.5AA batteries, shut the cover and fix the screw.
- 3. When the car slows down, change the batteries.
