

## Users Manual

1, Connect receiver's line marked +12V with positive pole of 12V DC power supply, and line marked GND with negative pole of that DC power supply.

2, Press the receiver button and hold, at the same time, press the button of the transmitter, and release all buttons when the receiver's buzzer sounds, it indicates that the receiver has received and saved the address code of transmitter. Even if power down the receiver, the receiver doesn't lose the address codes.

3, Within the radio of 0.5—3m from the receiver, press the button of a transmitter whose address code has been saved in the receiver memory, the receiver will receives message and transmits a group of data via the line marked "GPI/O 1".
