





BATTERY INSTALL / REPLACEMENT




1. Unscrew and remove battery cover with Phillips screwdriver.
2. Insert 4 "AA" batteries with polarity as shown in battery box.
3. Replace battery hatch and fasten in place with screw driver.

DRIVING YOUR TRACTOR TRAILER!

Basic Operation

- 1) Turn power switches on both the truck and the transmitter
- 2) Apply steering and throttle inputs slowly at first
- 3) Tractor Trailer works best on non-smooth surfaces (asphalt, carpet, concrete)



Truck

TRUCK BATTERY BOX

1. Unscrew battery cover on rear controller with Phillips screwdriver.
2. Insert 9V battery with polarity as shown in battery box.
3. Replace battery cover and fasten in place with screw driver.

Transmitter

9V

- 1) Turn power switches on both the truck and the transmitter
- 2) Apply steering and throttle inputs slowly at first
- 3) Tractor Trailer works best on non-smooth surfaces (asphalt, carpet, concrete)

WARNING!

- 1) Run time for Tractor Trailer is approx. 25-30 minutes.
- 2) Only operate your Tractor Trailer on sidewalks and playgrounds but NOT on roads where traffic is present.
- 3) Avoid using your Tractor Trailer outside when it is raining, snowing, thundering or other poor weather conditions.

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY BEFORE USING.

The improper use of the controller batteries may cause excessive heat, battery leakage, explosion and damage or lead to injury. Please read the instructions below.

- When you are running your Tractor Trailer, always keep it in your sight. Keep your Tractor Trailer away from roads or other areas where you might collide with people, pets or cars.
- When you are running the Tractor Trailer, always keep it in your sight. Avoid driving your Tractor Trailer under parked cars, etc.
- Keep your fingers, hair, face and clothing away from the spinning powered rear wheels.
- It is recommended that children be under adult supervision when they are playing with the Tractor Trailer.
- Keep away from fire or hot and/or humid environments.
- Do not disassemble the product.
- Do not place any objects on the spinning wheels.
- Do not start your Tractor Trailer when the front and rear wheels are unable to turn freely.
- Please keep this toy from children under 6 years old.
- Do not bend, tear, strongly hit or drop the truck, transmitter, antenna shaft, or antenna wire.

- When other radio controlled products with the same frequency are used nearby, this may cause interference and your Tractor Trailer may not work properly.

FCC REQUIREMENT




- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.
- Increase the separation between the equipment and receiver.
- Consult the dealer or an experienced radio/TV technician for help.
- Connect the equipment into an outlet on a circuit different from that to which the receiver is connected.

OPERATION

- 1) Adjust truck to drive straight ahead by turning adjust tab left or right.
- 2) Start by manually attaching cab to trailer. Drive as desired using throttle and steering joysticks on transmitter.
- 3) To disconnect trailer, press "raise" button on transmitter, support arm lowers and lifts/disconnects trailer hitch. Then, drive cab away.
- 4) To reconnect, manually place or steer cab just ahead of trailer (align in straight line). Press "lower" button on transmitter, trailer support arm lowers and trailer reconnects. Drive away.



Note: If truck is left "on", a 30 second "sleep" function is enabled which saves battery life. Reset power on/off switch to turn vehicle on again.
