

SPEED FLYER

HOW FAST DO YOU RUN?



CHECKING YOUR SPEED:

1. PRESS BUTTON 1 ONCE. YOUR "LAST" MEASURED SPEED SHOWS.
2. THEN PRESS BUTTON 2 ONCE. WHEN ALL 3 LIGHTS TURN ON, START RUNNING.
3. AS YOUR RUN, ALL 3 LIGHTS FLASH & THE SPEED COUNTER MEASURES YOUR SPEED.
4. WHEN YOU STOP RUNNING, THE SPEED COUNTER AUTOMATICALLY STOPS & DISPLAYS YOUR SPEED.

CHECKING YOUR LAST & HIGHEST SPEED:

1. PRESS BUTTON 1 ONCE. YOUR "LAST" SPEED SHOWS.
2. PRESS BUTTON 1 AGAIN. YOUR "HIGH" SPEED SHOWS.

SETTING THE TIME:

1. HOLD BUTTON 2 UNTIL "AM" OR "PM" FLASHES.
2. TO ADJUST "AM" OR "PM", PRESS BUTTON 1.
3. TO ADJUST THE "HOUR", PRESS BUTTON 2 UNTIL THE "HOUR" FLASHES.
PRESS BUTTON 1 TO ADJUST THE HOUR.
4. TO ADJUST THE "MINUTE", PRESS BUTTON 2 UNTIL THE "MINUTE" FLASHES.
PRESS BUTTON 1 TO ADJUST THE MINUTE.
