Gentlemen:

On behalf of the Applicant the following statement on Modular Approval is provided.

1. The modular transmitter has its own RF shielding. This ensures that the module does not have to rely upon the shielding provided by the device into which it is installed
2. The TF4BD101 has buffered modulation/data inputs to ensure that the module will comply with Part 15 requirements.
3. The module contains its own on-board power supply regulation.
4. The antenna is integrated with the module.
5. The modular transmitter was tested in a stand-alone configuration using a non-metallic test jig.
6. The modular is labeled with its own FCC ID number, and, as the FCC ID will not be visible when the module is installed inside another device, an exterior label will be used. An example label is provided with the application.
7. The device complies with Parts 15B, and 15.249 of the FCC Rules. A copy of instructions, specific to the Rule Parts, is included in the application for equipment authorization.
8. The module complies with the applicable RF exposure requirements and an MPE Assessment (47 CFR 1.1310) is included with the filing.
