This provides detailed information regarding the technical architecture of the product, in particular debug facility, Bluetooth, power supply, GSM, multimedia functionality and GPS. These are core functional components of the Gizmondo device, which makes it a unique within the market place.

The architecture is deemed to be a trade secret and is only privileged to certain key company Stakeholders and system developers. These are internally based and such disclosure to outside partie(s) would conflict with company policy, intellectual property and overall intellectual security.

The Gizmondo functionality has been designed within a small product size and therefore the intellectual architecture would be of extreme interest to competitors.
