HYON Functions



MP3 playback functions

Similar to other MP3s, HYON can playback Wma, OGG, and MP3 files. In addition, HYON works in conjunction with Melon, music service by SKT, to download and reproduce music files on your PC and mobile phone.



Phone functions

HYON is Bluetooth enabled so you can use Bluetooth headsets to receive and send calls.



Support bell sound function and manner mode using a built-in speaker

This product supports manner mode using a vibration motor along with MP3 bell sound function essential for phone function.



Supports a variety of call functions

HYON supports a variety of methods to converse on the phone. The MP3 earphone, external speakers, microphone, as well as the handset support telephone functions.



FM radio reception

In addition to MP3 playback, HYON serves as an FM radio.

**Supports USB 2.0**

HYON supports USB 2.0 to allow for fast transmission of data and serves as a portable memory device.

**Recording / direct encoding**

This product supports voice recordings, FM radio recordings, and direct encoding. The highly sensitive microphone assures clear call quality as well as excellent recording quality.

**Colorful LCD screen**

HYON utilizes 65,000 color LCDs.

**Supports a variety of multi-formats**

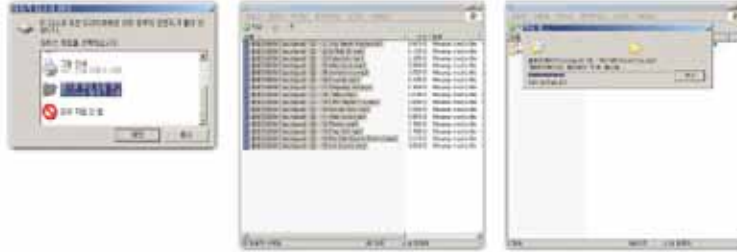

Connecting with Computer

Download

Downloading from a PC

By connecting the IU to the computer, the IU will be recognized as a portable disk, as shown in the picture. If the screen shown below pops up, select "open folder," then drag the MP3 file from the PC into the folder to begin downloading.



If you connect the PC to HYON with USB cable like downloading MP3 files, it is showed "USB Connected" on the LCD screen of HYON.

In case that it is maintained, it means HYON is charging from the PC automatically.

Basic Function



:: Listening to MP3 files



- 1 From the ready screen, rotate the disk to set to "melon play menu," then press "ok." Pressing the "Ok" continuously may open the directory screen.
※ Pressing the right directional key continuously could also open the directory screen.



- 2 The title of a saved MP3 file will be displayed. Find the desired file by pressing the "right/left directional key" and press "ok" to play selected file. Press "ok" again during playback to stop. Press "ok" continuously to turn off the unit.



- 3 During playback, use the "right/left directional keys" to select the previous or next song. Press the directional keys continuously to rewind or fast forward.

:: Listening to the FM radio



- 1 From the ready screen, rotate the disk and select "FM radio." In the radio menu, use the "up/down directional keys" to select "radio play" and the radio will turn on.



- 2 To turn the radio off, tap the "ok" key. To turn off the unit, press the "ok" key continuously. During radio play, rotate the disk to stop.



- 3 During radio play, use the "left/right directional keys" to select a preset station or change the frequency. Pressing the keys continuously activates the "previous/next channel scan" function.



- 4 Using the "up/down directional keys" adjusts volume. Pressing continuously will activate the continuous volume increase or decrease function.

Recording the FM radio



1 To make recordings of radio broadcasts, select "radio play" from the "radio menu" and select the desired channel.



2 The radio channel you selected will be played.



3 During radio play, press "OK" continuously to display the menu to stop radio play and record radio play. Select "record radio" to record the current channel's radio broadcast.



4 Press "OK" during recording to stop and go back to the previous menu.

Recording voice



1 From the "record radio" menu, you can select "mic recording," which allows you to record via a microphone, or "line-in recording," which allows you to record via line-in connections.



2 "Mic recording" begins once you connect a microphone to the IJ and select "mic recording" from the "recording" menu.

3 For "line-in recording," connect the cable to the line-in terminal, go to the "recording" menu, and select "line-in recording" to begin.



4 During recording, tap the "OK" button to stop.

☐ Making phone calls



1 Go to set phone menu and select "phone call".



Tap the left directional key to erase a selected number.



2 Use the "up/down key" to move to the desired number and press "OK" to select.



3 Tap the right directional key to complete inputting the phone number. Tap "OK" to place a call.



4 You can also select numbers from the "recently called" list and tap "OK" to place a call.



- ※ Your unit must support SKT PAN services unit to use this function.
- ※ The Bluetooth of your HYON must be on.
- ※ The PAN unit must be connected to HYON.
- ※ Refer to "other functions" menu page for HYON setting directions.
- ※ Refer to the PAN user manual for PAN connection directions.

Addition Function

Setting the radio



- 1 You may select "stereo mode" or "mono mode" from the radio setting menu. From the ready screen, rotate dial to select "radio" and press "OK" for the "radio" menu.



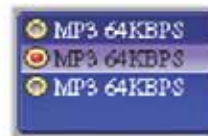
- 2 From the "radio" menu, use the up/down directional keys to select "radio setting" and press "OK".



- 3 From the "radio setting" menu, use the up/down directional keys to select between "stereo mode" and "mono mode." After your selection, press "OK" to exit.

Recording settings

1) Recording mode



- 1 From the "recording mode" menu, you may select the type of format you wish to save a recorded file. HYON supports "Wav" and "MP3" file formats.

- 2 From the "recording mode" menu, use the "up/down directional keys" to select the type of format you desire and press "OK" to save.

2) VAD



- 1 From the VAD menu, use the "up/down directional keys" to select among "High, Low, or Off" and press "OK" to save setting.



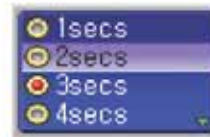
VAD allows you to decrease memory size by not recording when no sound is detected. This function could reduce the sound quality of the recording.

- 2 The "High" setting results in a smaller file size than the "Low" setting but the sound quality could be lower as well. Selecting "Off" would deactivate VAD.

3) Auto-sync



1 From the "recording mode" menu, use the "up/down directional keys" to select "Auto Sync" menu.



2 use the "up/down directional keys" to select among "1-4 seconds" and "Off" and press "OK" to save setting.

4) Recordings folder



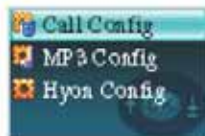
1 The "Recordings folder" stores recorded files from "mic recordings" and "line-in recordings."



TIP The auto-sync function recognizes gaps between tracks when recording from an outside source such as a CD so that each song is separated into a separate file.

Setting phone functions

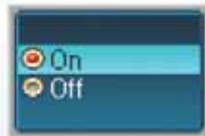
1) Bluetooth ON/OFF



1 From the "settings" menu, select "phone setting." Select desired recording type and press "OK" to save setting.



2 From the "phone setting" menu list, select "Bluetooth ON".



3 From the Bluetooth ON/OFF menu, you can activate or deactivate Bluetooth.



* HYON retains the last settings after power is switched on or off.
* When Bluetooth is turned on, HYON is connected to the PAN service unit and the connection is maintained until Bluetooth is turned off.

4) Setting your PIN code



- 1 From the "setting" menu, select "phone setting".



- 2 From the "phone setting" menu, select "PIN code setting".



- 3 Use the "up/down" keys to select the number and the "left/right" keys to move to the desired number.



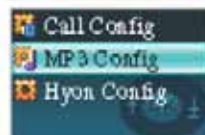
■ The "left/right" keys function differently at the ends of the list. Pressing "left" at the left end of the list takes you to the previous menu, pressing the "right" key at the right end of the list saves your selection.

Setting your MP3

1) EQ settings



- 1 From the ready screen, rotate the disk to select the "settings" menu and press "OK".



- 2 From the "settings" menu, press "OK" up or down to select "EQ settings" menu and tap "OK".

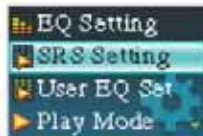


- 3 From the "EQ" mode, you can select among 7 settings, "Normal" / "Rock" / "Jazz" / "Classic" / "Pop" / "SR3 3D" / "QES" or you can select "Custom" and adjust pitch levels to tailor the sound to your preference.

2) Setting SRS effect



- 1 From the "settings" menu, select "MP3 settings" menu.

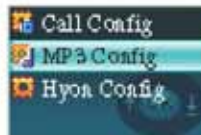


- 2 From the "MP3 settings" menu, select "SRS Setting" menu.

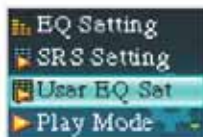


- 3 Use the "left/right directional keys" to select between "WOW" and "TrueBass" and use the "up/down" keys to adjust levels. Press "OK" to exit.

3) Adjusting user EQ



- 1 From the "settings" menu, select "MP3 settings" menu.



- 2 From the "MP3 settings" menu, select "User EQ setting" menu.



- 3 Use the "left/right" keys to select the preferred pitch. Use the "up/down" keys to adjust the level of the pitch and press "OK" to exit.

4) Playback mode



1 From the "settings" menu, select "MP3 settings".



2 Select "Playback mode".



3 Use the "left/right" keys to select pitch. Use the "up/down" keys to adjust the level of the pitch and press "OK" to exit.

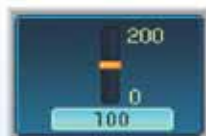
5) Playback speed



1 From the "settings" menu, select "MP3 settings".



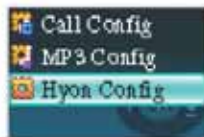
2 Select "Play Speed".



3 Use the "left/right" keys to select pitch. Use the "up/down" keys to adjust the level of the pitch and press "OK" to exit.

Setting HYON

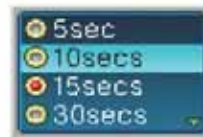
1) Low energy setting



- 1 From the "settings" menu, select "HYON settings".



- 2 Select "Idle Shutdown".

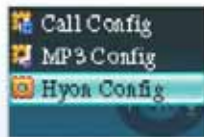


- 3 From the "HYON settings" menu, select "low energy". You can choose from 5 second to 30 seconds.



Low energy settings do not activate when Bluetooth is "ON".

2) HYON information



- 1 From the "settings" menu, select "HYON settings".



- 2 From the "HYON settings" menu, select "HYON information".



- 3 The "information" screen will appear with memory information.

3) Setting initialization



- 1 From the "settings" menu, select "HYON settings".



- 2 From the "HYON settings" menu, select "setting initialization".



- 3 When the message "Do you wish to initialize?" appears, selecting "Yes" would initialize settings to the factory setting and selecting "No" would return you to the previous menu.



Setting initialization would change all settings saved in the IU to the original factory settings. However, data saved in the memory will not be erased.

4) Format



- 1 From the "settings" menu, select "HYON settings".



- 2 From the "HYON settings" menu, select "format".



- 3 When the message "Would you like to format?" appears, selecting "Yes" would format and selecting "No" would return you to the previous menu.



Formatting would erase all data saved on HYON. However, user settings will not be erased.
