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


**Fig. 1 -OVERVIEW**




## QUICK START

### Charging your BLUEVOICE


- For the first time use, fully charge the unit in around 4 hours.
- A red light is on during charging, and it will be off when the battery is fully charged.
- Charging methods: (see the Fig. 3 below)

## QUICK START

### For the handsfree unit:

#### When the handsfree unit is off:

- **For paring with your mobile phone**, press and hold the main button until the blue and red light is blinking alternately, the unit is in paring mode. Then activate your mobile phone to search the handsfree unit. Once the unit is identified by your phone, press the password "0000" to confirm the paring, and the handsfree unit is ready for use with your phone.

- **To turn on the unit**, press and hold the main button for 2 seconds (and then release), blue light is blinking, the unit is in stand-by mode.

#### When the handsfree unit is on:

- **To take an incoming call**, press the main button once.

- **To reject an incoming call**, press and hold the main button until the call is rejected.


- **Adjust the volume** when talking with the handsfree unit, press volume UP and DOWN accordingly.

- **To end the call when in talking mode**, press and hold the main button.

- **To dial the last dialled number**, press and hold the volume DOWN key for few seconds when in standby status, until a "beep" sound is heard.

### For the watch function:

- Press MODE button to change mode, the sequence is:



## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Thank you for your purchasing the BLUEVOICE. To fully appreciate all the features of your BLUEVOICE, please follow the steps in the following sections.

### Summary of features

Chronotech BLUEVOICE is a special product that combined Bluetooth handsfree unit and a sophisticated digital watch. Unlike other handsfree units, BLUEVOICE can be attached onto the strap when in standby status, which provides maximum comfort to the user since he/she does not need to wear the main unit all the time.

The following are the summary of features:

### Charge your BLUEVOICE

Please fully charge the main unit for the first time use. Normally the battery will be fully charged in 2-3 hours. When the main unit is charging, a red light is on until the unit is fully charged.

There are 3 ways for user to charge their BLUEVOICE: (see Fig. 3)

- 1-Use the AC adaptor to charge the BLUEVOICE from a power socket.
- 2-Charging directly from your computer's USB socket with the USB cable
- 3-Charging from your car's cigar lighter socket with the optional car-charging plug

## GLOSSARY

**Bluetooth** is a radio technology developed to connect devices, such as mobile phones and headsets, without wires or cords over a short distance of maximum 10 meters (approx. 30 feet). More information is available at [www.bluetooth.com](http://www.bluetooth.com)

**Paring** creates a unique and encrypted communication link between two Bluetooth enabled devices and allows them to communicate with each other. Bluetooth devices will not work if the devices have not been paired with each other.

**Password, passkey or pin** is a code that needs to be entered on the phone in order to pair the mobile phone with the BLUEVOICE. When you have already paired your mobile with the headset, the phone and the BLUEVOICE will recognize each other automatically accept the transmission.

**Standby mode** is when the BLUEVOICE is passively waiting for a call. When you "END" the call on your mobile phone, the BLUEVOICE will go into standby mode.



**In time setting mode**

- When entered into the time setting mode, the second is blinking and ready for setting. Press ST./STP. button to set the second to zero.
- Press RESET button to select the value for setting, the selection sequence is:

**SECOND → HOUR → MINUTE → MONTH → DATE → DAY OF WEEK**



- For setting other value, press ST./STP. button to advance the digit
- Press MODE button to exit the time setting mode and return to normal time mode

Note: When setting the hour, letter "A" and "P" represent AM and PM of 12 hour format respectively, letter "H" represents the 24 hour format.

Anytime press the LIGHT button, the EL backlight will be on.

**WARNING**

- Please turn off the handsfree unit before putting it into your pocket/bag/brief case. It avoided dialling out accidentally.
- Do not expose your BLUEVOICE under water or other liquid, it is not water-resistant.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean your BLUEVOICE.
- Do not expose your BLUEVOICE under high or low temperature.
- Do not expose your BLUEVOICE to contact with any sharp-pointed objects, as this will cause scratches and damage.
- Do not attempt to disassemble your BLUEVOICE which does not contain any serviceable components.
- If you do not use your BLUEVOICE for a long period, please make sure it is stored in a dry place at room temperature.
- Do not attempt to replace the built-in battery on your own, it is not changeable.
- The battery can only be recharged by the chargers provided by the manufacturer.
- Do not disassemble the charger as it may expose you to the dangerous of electric shock.
- Do not use the charger in outdoor, or in high humidity environment.
- Avoid charging your BLUEVOICE in high temperature environment.
- To avoid electromagnetic interference and/or compatibility conflicts, turn off your BLUEVOICE in any facility where posted notices instruct you to do so. For example hospitals, health care facilities and aircraft are using equipment that is sensitive to external RF energy.
- It is suggested a minimum distance of 15 cm (6 inches) should be maintained between a handheld wireless device (i.e. your BLUEVOICE) and a pacemaker.
- Dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Do not dispose as household waste.

**Operation of the handsfree unit****Use of interchangeable earplugs**

There are 3 different sizes earplugs provided for you, you may choose the most comfortable one for yourself. The Fig. 4 shows how to interchange the earplug.

**Turn on the handsfree unit**

When the handsfree unit is off, press and hold the main button for 2 seconds to turn on the unit, a blue light will blink during the unit is on. A short "beep" sound is generated (from the earplugs speaker).

Please note that the watch display is always on (unless the battery is out), which does not represent the handsfree unit is on too.

**Turn off the handsfree unit**

When the unit is on, press and hold the main button for 3 seconds to turn off the unit, a red light will blink few times before the handsfree unit is off. A long "beep" sound is generated (from the earplug speaker).

Again, the watch will keep working even if the handsfree unit is off.

**Pair your BLUEVOICE with mobile phone**

Before you do pairing, make sure the handsfree unit is off.

- Keep your BLUEVOICE and phone in around 1 meter.
- To set the handsfree unit into the pairing mode, press and hold the main button until the red and blue light blink alternately.
- Follow your phone's instruction, activate your phone's searching function for Bluetooth handsfree unit.
- Once your phone found the handsfree unit, your phone display will show "BLUEVOICE". Please select it and confirm with the password: 0000. The phone will confirm the pairing is completed. In case of unsuccessful pairing, please go through the above steps again.
- Once pairing is successful, your handsfree unit is in stand-by mode.

Note: If pairing process cannot complete within 2 minutes, red light will blink with 3 "beep" sound. Then the handsfree unit is off, please go through the above steps again.

When a call is in or dial out a call, your phone will connect the handsfree unit automatically. If the connection is broken, please try either one of the following procedures (make sure the BLUEVOICE and your phone are located in less than 1 meter area):

- Press the main button of your BLUEVOICE, your phone will detect it and press YES to accept the connection.
- Access your phone's Bluetooth devices connection manual, choose "BLUEVOICE" and confirm the connection.

Please note that you just need to do pairing once for the first time use, the paired data will be stored in the handsfree unit and your mobile phone.

#### Answer a call

When there is an incoming call, a ring tone is generated through the earplug speaker. Just press the main button of your BLUEVOICE to pick up the call.

#### End a call

When in talking status, press and hold the main button of your BLUEVOICE to end a call.

#### Reject a call

When there is an incoming call, press and hold the main button of your BLUEVOICE until the call is rejected.

#### Adjust the volume and mute function

During the phone call, press volume UP or DOWN keys to adjust the volume of the speaker accordingly.

#### Last dialled number redial


For redialling the last dialled number in stand-by mode, press and hold the volume DOWN key until a "beep" sound is heard.

#### Low battery indication

When the battery power is low, a red light will blink and the main unit will have a "beep" sound (from the earplug speaker) every one minute. At this moment, please charge your main unit and follow the steps in "Charge your BLUEVOICE" section.

## Operation of the watch function

There are 4 modes of watch function, press MODE button to change mode, and the mode sequence is shown below:



#### In normal time mode

-Press MODE button to change to chronograph mode.

#### In chronograph mode

-Press ST./STP. button to activate the chronograph  
 -During the chronograph is running, press RESET button to take the lap time  
 -During the chronograph is running, press ST./STP button to stop counting  
 -When the chronograph is stopped, press RESET button to reset the counter to zero  
 -Press MODE button to change to alarm mode

#### In alarm mode

-Press ST./STP. button to toggle the ON/OFF of the daily alarm and hourly chime, the sequence is:



-Press RESET button to set the hour of the alarm time, and press ST./STP. button to advance the digit  
 -Press RESET button again to set the minute of the alarm time, and press ST./STP. button to advance the digit  
 -Press RESET button again to exit the alarm setting mode  
 -Press MODE button to change to time setting mode

When the alarm is ringing, press any key to stop the alarm.
