Is the agent for service of process required to have an FRN?

If the agent for service of process does business with the FCC, it should have an FRN, and that FRN is required to be included on the attachment/certification letter designating the agent for service of process. If the agent for service of process does no business with the FCC other than being designated as a U.S. agent for service of process, a separate FRN is not required; in such case, only the grantee's FRN is required to be included on the attachment/certification letter designating the U.S. agent for service of process.

If the applicant (grantee) is located in the U.S., can it be its own agent for service of process? Yes. If the applicant (grantee) chooses to be its own agent for service of process, the applicant (grantee) still must submit a certification, including the required contact information for the agent for service of process, designating itself and agreeing to accept service of process.
