The enclosed documents constitute a formal submittal and application for a Class II Permissive Change for an 802.11abg module pursuant to the following rules:

Subpart C of Part 15 of FCC Rules (CFR 47)
RSS-Gen Issue 3, December 2010, "General Requirements and Information for the Certification of Radiocommunication Equipment"
RSS-210, Issue 8, December 2010, "Low-power Licence-exempt Radiocommunication Devices (All Frequency Bands): Category I Equipment"

The applicant has modified the layout of the previously approved device for a specific use application. The modified module was tested with the antenna that is intended to be used in the specific use application. The new module will be limited to this antenna, and will not use the antennas listed in the original filing.

Only transmitter radiated spurious emissions was performed. The output power was verified to be consistent with the original filing.
