We will ensure all OEM integrators understand that this module is approved only for OEM integration in laptops (i.e. notebooks and netbooks), and tablets with overall diagonal dimension of the keyboard and/or display section is > 20 cm. We will also ensure all OEM integrators follow our instructions for antenna placement that satisfies the requirement of minimum separation distance for laptop and tablet host platforms. We will also ensure all OEM integrators understand their responsibility for additional testing to verify compliance as a composite system with respect to the FCC Part 15 Subpart B and RF exposure requirement, while the transmitter module(s) are installed and operating. The modules should be transmitting and the evaluation should confirm that the module's intentional emissions are compliant (i.e. fundamental and out of band emissions). The host manufacturer must verify that there are no additional unintentional emissions other than what is permitted in Part 15 Subpart B or emissions are complaint with the transmitter(s) rule(s).
