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SUBJECT: Class II Permissive Change for FCC ID: **TX2-RTL8852CE**

The intention of this application is to enable the modular FCC ID: **TX2-RTL8852CE**, granted on **12/20/2022** to be integrated in **Lenovo Notebook Computer, Legion Slim 7 16IRH8**. And will be permanently disabled the Wi-Fi 5GHz UNII-4 band operation by software. It cannot be enabled/overridden by end users or unauthorized 3rd parties via any other mean.

The module installed into host platform mentioned above is electronically and mechanically identical to the original certified module. The Original FCC testing on module under FCC ID: **TX2-RTL8852CE** was performed with an antenna of higher gain, and the antenna was connected to the module in an open environment. The current host platform under application uses an antenna of the same type but of lower gain and is installed inside the host platform enclosure. The physical restraints introduced by the host platform should have resulted in equal or lower level of radiated emission. Therefore, additional Radiated emission testing is not necessary. Software security remains unchanged from the original application.

Except for the change above, the design, hardware and implementation are exactly same with original.
