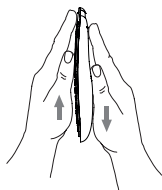

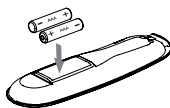
Inserting, removal and replacement of remote control batteries.

Declaración de conformidad de la FCC

Este equipo se ha examinado y se ha comprobado que cumple con los límites establecidos para un equipo digital de clase B, conforme a la parte 15 de las reglas de FCC.
