The intent of this letter is to request a Class II Permissive change for FCC ID: TZQWQ110MC, originally granted on 11/5/2007.


WiQuest Communications Inc. has implemented a BIOS Lock mechanism for products that ship under FCC ID: TZQWQ110MC. The BIOS Lock mechanism addresses the following:

- Prevents the module from functioning in an unauthorized system
- Prevents a module from being moved from an authorized system to an unauthorized system
- Allows the module to function properly in an authorized system

The change filed under this application requests the removal of the following limitation from the grant: "This device must be installed by the OEM integrator. User installation is prohibited."

No other changes have been made to the Transmitter Module.
