This letter is to certify that the module submitted for approval as FCC ID U3V6221020 meets the requirements for a UNLICENSED MODULAR TRANSMITTER as specified in FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407. Specifically,

- 1) Per clause 1, this device includes an integral shield over the transceiver and microprocessor as can be seen in the photographs of the module.
- 2) Per clause 2, all data input to the module occurs through either DIO channels or AD channels on the microprocessor effectively isolating them from the transceiver stage of the circuit.
- 3) Per clause 3, the module has an on board voltage regulator that provides power for the microprocessor and the transceiver.
- 4) Per clause 4, the antenna is permanently soldered to the module.
- 5) Per clause 6, V1.10 was upgraded to V1.12 to include a permanent silkscreen of the FCC ID number. Because this label will not be visible in normal usage, page 1 of the operator's manual includes instructions for proper labeling of any device that will incorporate this module. Further, the manual also details that the module is only intended to be incorporated into Ohio Willow Wood Co products by Ohio Willow Wood Co. Ohio Willow Wood Co thereby maintains control over usage of the module and can assure proper labeling of the end products using this module.
