How to use Bluetooth

Power on / off

Automatically power on is once you put "Soundfly view" into the car cigarette lighter socket. You can also power on & off by pressing the Power button for about 2 seconds ()

Pairing Phone

To pair Soundfly View with your mobile phone:

- 1.Enter Main menu -> Bluetooth -> Pairing Phone
- 2.Soundfly View waits for 3 minute to be connected with your mobile phone.
- 3.Connect your mobile phone to select for New Bluetooth devices.
- Select Soundfly View from the mobile phone.
- (Verify Bluetooth function is active on your mobile phone)
4. Depending on the device, you might have to enter the password "0000".
5. If there is no signal after 3min of waiting, Soundfly View stop connecting automatically.

Select Phone

Soundfly View shows the name of the previously paired Phone. You can select the device from the list to pair with Soundfly View again. Enter Main Menu -> Bluetooth -> Select Phone

Last device conn

By default, Soundfly View connects to the last connected phone automatically once power is on. To turn it off, select "No" on the following menu.

Enter Main Menu -> Bluetooth -> Last device conn

Audio route transferring

While on a call on Soundfly View, briefly press  button to transfer the audio to the mobile phone, and to transfer a call from the mobile phone to Soundfly view, press  again.

To manually select & activate this function
Enter Main menu -> Bluetooth -> Bluetooth option -> Audio route -> BT Handsfree or Mobile phone

Select speaker

Enter Main menu -> Bluetooth -> Bluetooth option -> Select speaker
Select * LEFT + RIGHT* or LEFT ONLY

Phonebook sync

You can synchronize your Contacts(Phonebook) on your Mobile phone with Soundfly View through Soundfly View :

1. Enter Main menu -> Contact list -> Phonebook
2. Enter Quick menu -> Phonebook
3. Press & Hold Jog button for about 3 second to access Phonebook directly

2. All of your contacts are displayed alphabetically in a list. It is easy to search for a contact by name. (LCD starts with the Alphabet where it was "paused last time")

It is easy to search for a contact by name.
Press Jog button to open its entry where you wish to find in the list.

To dial a number, press Jog button

How to use FM Transmitter

Getting Started Part 1

When using Soundfly View with Memory device

Music files such as MP3/WMA, stored in your SD cards
can be played through FM transmission.

1. The Soundfly view is automatically turned on once it is placed into the car cigarette lighter socket.

2. Place SD card into the Soundfly view

- select the mode desired: USB memory or SD memory if both is in.

3. Turn the car radio on and select a frequency that is not being used for broadcasting.

- match the frequency of the Soundfly view to your radio by turning the Jog button to the left/right to browse stations.

4. Plug your SD, or MMC memory device into the Soundfly view

- audio files are played automatically

- supported audio files are MP3 and WMA;
other audio file types are not supported (format type: FAT32)

5. Set the volume with the volume setting function on the Soundfly view

Functions and Operations

[Selecting the track and playback]

1. Press Jog button twice to play/pause a track while playing
2. Skip to the previous or next track by turning the Jog button or   buttons while a track is playing.
3. Skip to the previous or next folder by pressing & holding the Jog button for about 2 sec. or   buttons while a track is playing.

(The first track in the folder will play)

[Setting the frequency]

1. Enter Main menu -> System config -> FM Frequency
2. Select the desired frequency with Jog button (0.1MHz) or   buttons. (1MHz)

[Contrast Setting]

1. Enter Main menu -> System config -> LCD contrast. (from 0 to 20)
2. Adjust the contrast to desired level using the Jog button or   buttons.

[Backlight color]

To apply Desired Backlight color to Soundfly View

Enter Main menu -> System config -> Backlight color

You can choose from "Orange color" / White color / Yellow color"

[Volume announce]

Volume announcement is set to On by default.

To turn the following options off.

Enter Main menu -> System config -> Volume announce

*BT voice: To announce a start of Bluetooth music

*MP3 voice: To announce a start of Memory device music

*Call voice: To announce a phone number of incoming call

Functions of Remote control -1

Source select(SD , A2DP mode)

Take a call, Change audio pass route

Refuse a call, End a call, End A2DP

Make a call from P.B

Move to previous folder, Folder Navi

Move to previous track, Searching P.B

Rewind, PhoneBook

Shuttle, Repeat, Normal

Bookmark, A-B repeat

Source select(SD , A2DP mode)

[Detailed operations]

Remove the protective sticker before using the remote control.

[Selecting navigation mode]

Press the NAVI button to navigate through the folders and files stored in the memory devices for faster browsing. (Folder Navigation: Press  button)


Safety precautions

1. This product should be used only for 12V ~ 24V cigarette lighter socket power.
2. Do not start your car by putting a Soundfly into the cigarette lighter socket because the fuse could be burnt out.
3. Operate the device while the car is stopped to avoid the car accident.
4. Never use the device while driving.
5. Avoid using the device in strong magnetic field.
6. Do not subject the device to severe impact or dropping from high position.
7. Keep the device away from any liquid.
8. We are not responsible for damages caused by misusing and repairing the device or having replacement.
9. Please Soundfly when you stop the car or disconnect portable hard disk to avoid damage to Soundfly or hard disk.
10. Please be careful when you pull out the Soundfly view from the cigarette lighter jack not to get damaged to Gooseneck.

Description & Function



*Jog button: Turn the Jog button to move next / previous data
Press the Jog button to choose the option briefly
Press twice the Jog button to play/pause the music
Press briefly the Jog button to stop the music
Press & Hold the Jog button for about 1sec. to move previous menu
Press & Hold the Jog button for about 2 sec. to access "Main Menu"
Press & Hold the Jog button for about 3sec. to access "Phonebook"

*Move to previous menu: Press briefly to move to Previous menu.
But this doesn't work during phonebook searching

*Play mode: Press & Hold to change play mode. (Shuffle, Repeat, Normal in sequence)

*Bookmark: Press briefly where you wish to store the point in the file before you shut the device off.

Answering a call

All incoming calls: stop the Music playback & show the phone number on LCD display. Press Jog button or  button to answer an incoming call.

The most recent incoming calls are recorded in the Call log.

The music starts to play at the position where it was paused after a call.

End a call

Briefly press the Jog button or  button

Making a call

Dial the desired phone number at your mobile phone.

The display of the Soundfly View shows "Make Call".

You can also make calls from your Phonebook list, from the call , and using Voice dialer.

Last number redial

Briefly Press *  button twice to call the last number dialed

Refuse a call

Briefly press the  button to refuse a call when ringing

Call waiting

When you're on a call, Call waiting alerts you of incoming calls by sounding a beep instead of a ring. Soundfly View informs you that another call is coming in and displays the caller's phone number.

*Accept: Press  to terminate the first call while answering a second call

*Ignore: Press  to send the call to your voicemail box

Answer a second call without hanging up the first call by pressing Jog button. The first caller is placed on hold. Press Jog button to return the original call

Recent call log

To access the Recent call log, Press  briefly or

Press & hold the Jog button for 1 second to enter the Quick menu.

You will see "Recent" at the top of the list. (saves up to 20)
