	<h2>Introduction</h2> <p>The Bluetooth technology is a standard for wireless short distance radio communications. Devices like headset, mobile phone or PDA can communicate with each other without wires within approximately 10 meters. The Tendystar E2 headset is a wireless headset based on the Bluetooth technology. It supports two profiles: Headset profile and Hands-free profile. It will work with any qualified Bluetooth device (including headset or PDA) that supports the Headset profile or Hands-free profile. It also will allow you to take a call and adjust the volume without touching your mobile phone.</p>

<h2>Headset feature</h2>	
 <p>In the package</p> <p>Headset, Travel charger, Manual</p>	<p>Rejecting a call</p> <p>Press and hold the TALK button for 3 seconds when the headset is ringing.</p> <p>Adjusting the volume</p> <p>Press the VOL+ button to increase the volume and press the VOL- to decrease the volume.</p> <p>Muting the volume</p> <p>Press and hold VOL+ button and VOL- button for 3 second until you hear a beep. To end the mute function, press the VOL+ button and VOL- button until you hear a beep.</p>

<p>Redial the last number</p> <p>Press and hold the VOL-button about 3 seconds.</p> <p>Ending a call</p> <p>To end a call, press the TALK button during a call.</p> <p>Answering a call</p> <p>Once you hear an incoming call ring in the headset, press the talkbutton.</p>	<p>Charging</p> <p>At the first time, you must fully recharge it for about 8 hours until the blue indicator light turns on. For the subsequent charges, the charging will only take about 2hours. During the charge, both red and blue indicator lights turn to red. The indicator light will turn to blue when the charge is finished. While the battery is under-power, the indicator light will turn on; at last the indicator light will turn to blue.</p> <p>*Be sure charging the battery with the supplied charger. *Not allow the charging time more than 12 hours.</p> <p>Wearing the headset</p> <p>E2 is tied with a nice neck strap. During calling, wear the headset on the ear, without calling, it looks like a beautiful decoration hung on your neck.</p>

<h2>Using the headset</h2>	
<p>Turning the headset on</p> <p>Press and hold the TALK button for 3 seconds, then the blue indicator light flashes rapidly.</p> <p>Turning the headset off</p> <p>Press and hold the TALK button for 3 seconds, then the indicator light turn to red and flashes rapidly.</p>	<p>Pairing the headset</p> <p>Pairing is the connection between two Bluetooth devices to exchange data. The steps as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.Press and hold the TALK button about 6 seconds until the indicator light flashes red and blue alternatively. Now, the headset is pairing mode.2.With your mobile device , search for the headset TDSTAR-E2.3.Enter the headset passkey of 0000.4.The Tendystar-E2 Bluetooth headset will now ready to use with your mobile device. <p>Making a call</p> <p>Dial a phone number on the mobile phone. If your mobile phone offers the voice recognition feature, you could make a call directly from the headset. Press the TALK button and say one of your recorded voice tags, *</p> <p>*Make sure the voice tags have been recorded into the mobile phone.</p>
