



Amaryllo Trinity**På/Av-knapp och mini USB-anslutning****Läggning av batterier**

Bluetooth-gränssnitt

Installationen av mottagaren Amaryllo Trinity sker i följande tre enkla steg:

- Slå först på din Bluetooth värd enhet (PDA, Smartphone och PC). Du kan läsa i manualen för enheten hur den ansluts till en annan Bluetooth-enhet (SPP).
- Sätt på Amaryllo Trinity. Din värd enhet hittar Amaryllo Trinity som **Bluetooth GPS** på dess Bluetooth sökskärm.
- Under anslutningen kommer en hopparningskod att bes om, den är **0000**, nu skapar den en ny COM-port som används av din applikation. Använd **NMEA 115200 baud** för överföringen .





Maintenance and tips

Cleaning the unit

Please turn off the device and unplug before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the device. If necessary, slightly moisten the cloth. Do not use abrasive cleanser, wax or solvents (such as painter thinner or cleaning alcohol), since they may dull the finish or damage the surface of the unit.

Theft

Do not leave the Amaryllo Trinity in your parked car. This device is very attractive to steal from your car. Store the device in a non-visible way or take it with you out of the car.

Warranty

Amaryllo warrants to the original purchaser of this product that it shall be free of defects resulting from workmanship or components for a period of two (2) years from the date of sale. Defects covered by this warranty shall be corrected either by repair or, at Amaryllo's discretion by replacement. In the event of replacement, the replacement unit will be warranted for the remainder of the original two (2) years or thirty (30) days, whichever is longer. There are no other oral or written warranties, expressed or implied, including but not limited to those of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

This limited warranty is non-transferable and does not apply if the product has been damaged by negligence, accident, abuse, misuse, modification, misapplication, shipment to the manufacturer or service by someone other than Amaryllo.
