Blue "RX" =Receiver Red "TX" =Transmitter




Product function guide

3.5mm interface

Connect sound card ,
mobile phone,etc.


Indicator light

- 1.The red light is always on when charging,
and the red light is off when fully charged.
- 2.Flasihg blue light means it is waiting for pairing,
and the blue light is always on when the pairing is successful.



3.5mm interface

Connect to monitor earphone, and then you can
receive audio synchronously in real time.

Button


1. Turn on: Long press until the indicator light turns blue.
2. Turn off: press and hold until the indicator light goes out.
3. Pairing: the blue light flashes after power on,
double-click a button and then double-click another button.
The blue light will be on after successful pairing.
If the blue lights of both devices are on, the pairing is successful.

How to use


Use the transmitter:

Wear the product on the person who needs to talk, and then you can record the sound.




How to use monitor headphones:

Insert the monitor earphone into the transmitter




Step-2:

How to use the receiver:


Connect the audio cable to the 3.5mm interface of the receiving end and devices such as sound card, mobile phone, etc. (The mobile phone interface needs to support CTIA standard)



How to use

In use status:

After the product is turned on and successfully connected, the radio can be synchronized.
