Manual for the Sezmi remote

In order to get the unit working, please perform the following steps:

- a) Pairing of the unit.
- b) Communication can be done either via RF or IR.
- c) The selection can be done by using the keypad.
- d) Another way to make your selection is via the scroll key.

Pairing:

- a) Press the select Key
- b) Wait for an audio response from the remote
- c) Keep on pressing until there is a pairing success on the display.

User Selection

- a) Press one of the color keys in front of the remote.
- b) Each of the keys is for different user.
- c) The user then can make the specification selection.

INFORMATION TO USER
