Request for Modular Approval Attestation for the  
Bluetooth Module(FCC ID: VCPKB11R)

Per the FCC Public Notice DA-00-1407 for Part 15 Unlicensed Modular Transmitter approval the following information is provided:

- 1) "The modular transmitter must have it's own shield." There is shield present on the PCB, covering the section of RF .
- 2) "The modular transmitter must have buffered modulation/data inputs". Input signal buffered by 8MB Flash memory.
- 3) "The modular transmitter must have it's own power supply regulation." The module has its own power supply with AAA battery.
- 4) "The modular transmitter must comply with the antenna requirements of Section 15.203 and 15.204(c)." The device contains a built-in antenna which is not possible for replace.
- 5) "The modular transmitter must be tested in a stand-alone configuration, i.e., must not be inside another device during testing." The Module was tested as a standalone device, not inside any other equipment.
- 6) The modular transmitter will be labeled with the FCC ID: VCPKB11R, and, if the FCC ID is not visible when the module is installed inside another device, then the outside of the device into which the module is installed must also display a label referring to the enclosed module. This exterior FCC ID Label will use wording, "Contains RFID Transmitter Module FCC ID: VCPKB11R".
- 7) "The modular transmitter must comply with any specific rule or operating requirements applicable to the transmitter and the manufacturer must provide adequate instructions..." The necessary explanations to comply with this requirement are contained in the manual.
- 8) "The modular transmitter must comply with any applicable RF exposure requirements." The module has very low levels of RF energy that it is deemed to comply without testing of specific absorption ratio(SAR).
