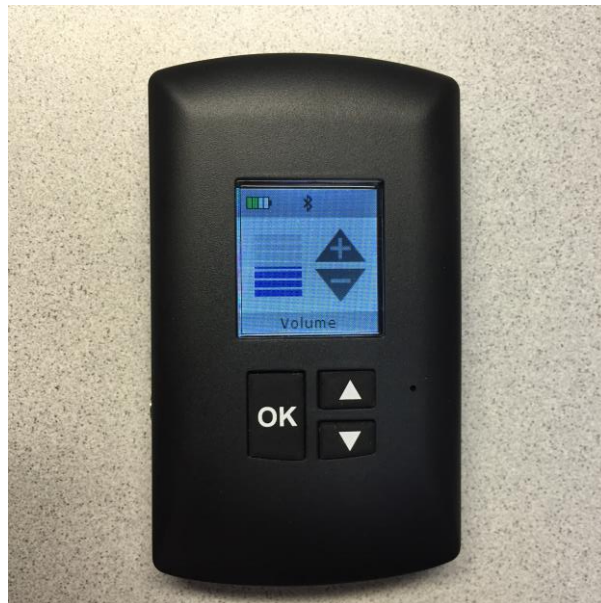
1. Access to IDs on the Relay

Certification IDs can be quickly accessed in the Relay's menu system, by accessing the "About" screens. This is accomplished by doing the following:

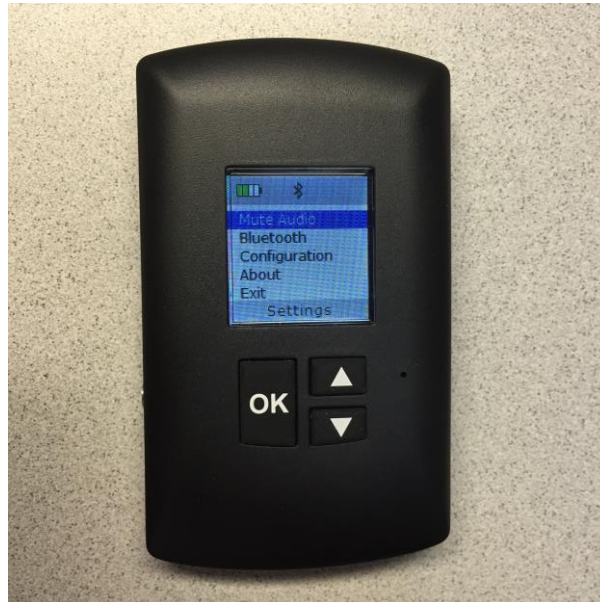
- From any main screen, press and hold the "OK" button. This brings up the "Settings" screen.
- Use the arrow buttons to select "About", and press "OK".
- Use the arrow buttons to scroll to the pages with the relevant IDs.

The process is illustrated in the photos below:

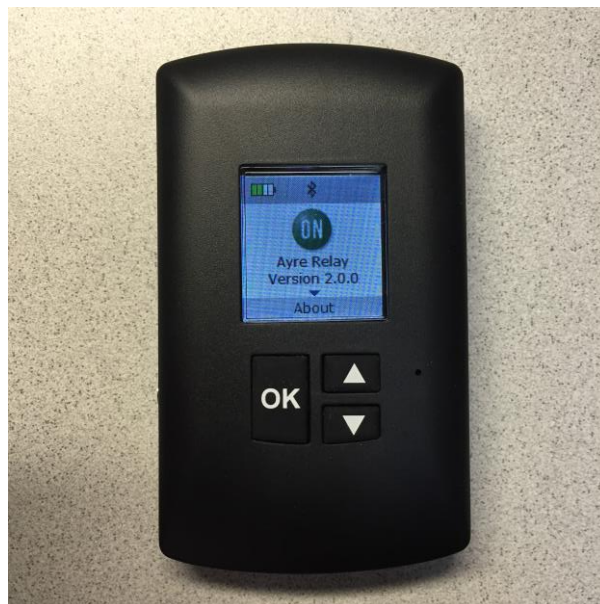
Main Screen:



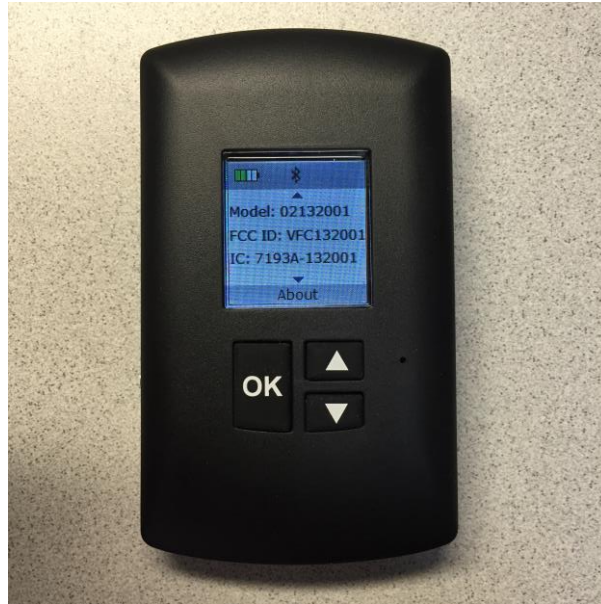
Pressing and holding the OK button brings up the Settings screen:



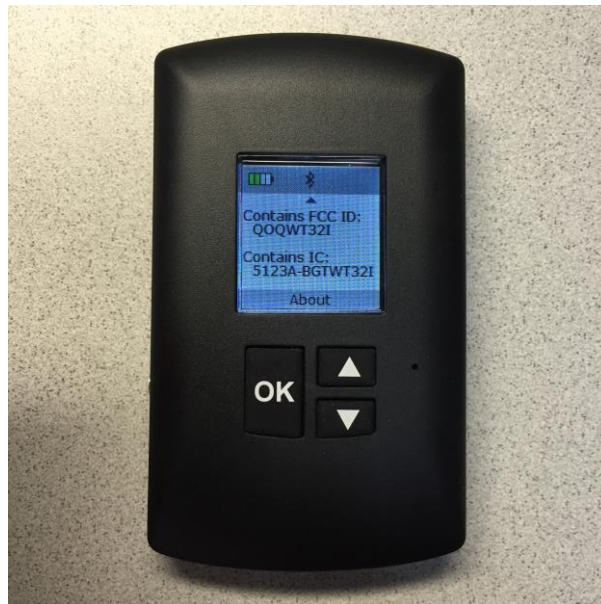
Selecting “About” brings up the logo and firmware version, with an arrow at the bottom of the screen indicating that more information is available for viewing, by scrolling downward:



Pressing the down arrow key brings up the Model/FCC/IC info screen:



Pressing the down arrow key again brings up the “Contains” FCC/IC info screen:



2. Labeling of IDs on the Relay

The required IDs are also present on the Relay, in the form of labels affixed to the removable screen protector that is shipped with the Relay from the factory, as follows:



3. Required Information in the User Guide

The User Guide for the Relay contains the required certification information and instructions for accessing this information on the Relay itself, beginning on page 44. Required warnings are also included in this section.

The generic version of the User Guide is attached in Appendix A, for reference. Note that both the Relay and the User Guide can be slightly customized for each individual customer, allowing them to add their own logo and individual Bluetooth® registration information. These items are highlighted in **green** in the User Guide.
