8. WIFI setup

8.1 Turn on WIFI

Click [] in function menu first, click "Set" to enter setup menu, then click "Wireless & network" to do setting, and place a check mark in Wi-Fi bar. As shown in figure below:

8.2 WIFI setting and WIFI network

Click "Wi-Fi setting", and system will search WIFI network automatically, as shown in figure below, two WIFI network were searched, and displays signal strength.



8.3 IP address setting and connecting: two ways

A. Auto Obtain IP address:

System default is IP address auto obtaining, click the target network name, input password according to whether there is Permission set, click "KW" network as picture below to pop up Password Input Window. Input right password, and click it; after through KW network's verification, system will auto obtain IP address from KW network, as shown in figure below:

B. Manually Obtain IP address:

Click [] first in Wi-Fi settings menu, and then "Advanced", place a check mark in "Use static IP" bar.

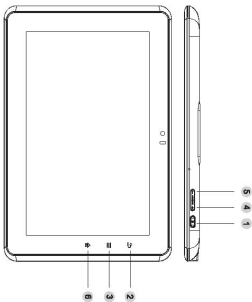

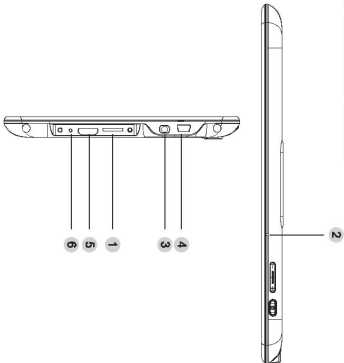

2. Mainframe introduction



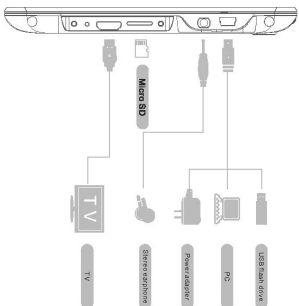
- 1 Power: a, long press it to turn on or pop up Shutdown windows;
b, press it to enter standby mode or exit
c, long press for 6s to turn off
- 2 Return: exit or return
- 3 Menu: a, confirm;
b, press it to pop up setup menu
c, press it to unlock
- 4 Volume+: increase the volume
- 5 Volume-: decrease the volume
- 6 Home: return to Main Menu

3. Interface introduction



- 1 Micro SD: insert Micro SD card;
- 2 MIC: can do record and chat on line by third-party software;
- 3 Earphone: connect to earphone to output stereo;
- 4 USB OTS: a, connect to PC to transfer data;
b, connect to USB flash drive, HDD or others through USB Host Cable, (External power is needed);
c, connect to USB power adapter or PC to charge the device;
- 5 HDMI: HD output; can connect to TV, monitor or other similar devices with HDMI input interface;
- 6 Reset: To reset the machine; if system hails or has delayed reaction, you can insert a Spike into the aperture to forcibly turn off.

5. Turn on/off

Turn on and unlock the screen: In Power off state, long press "POWER" button to enter Android system's Boot screen; after enter the desktop, touch and drag the icon to unlock, as shown in figure below:



6. Battery management and charging

- A, In the first use of the device, it should charge the device for 5-6 hours to make sure the battery has been fully charged.
- B, Connect the Power adapter to the device by USB cable, then let power adapter connect to power socket; the battery icon on desktop displays as [Battery icon], and green bar is rolling, which means the device is charging. Don't unplugging the charger in charging. After fully charged, the battery icon on desktop displays as [Battery icon], and the green bar stops rolling.
- Note: Lithium battery doesn't need to discharge or charge it after battery runs out, you can charge it when the battery has not run out.
