Per your request, following is Black Diamond Advanced Technology's written statement regarding compliance of the SwitchBack Ultra Mobile PC to FCC Rule Section 15.247(b)(5) for the purpose of TCB submittal.

The SwitchBack™ is a fully rugged Ultra Mobile Personal Computer (UMPC). The SwitchBack Ultra Mobile PC is designed to be operated in a two-handed handheld fashion or "docked" in a desktop or vehicle mount application. SwitchBack has user interfaces including a thumb operated keypad, backlit Liquid Crystal Display (LCD) with touch-screen, and integrated thumb operated mouse pointer. SwitchBack is designed to be used in indoor and outdoor environments, including harsh conditions, in a two-handed hand-held fashion. Its external dimensions are 7.5" x 5.5" x 2". SwitchBack is sufficiently large to prohibit it from being placed inside a shirt or pants pocket. SwitchBack has no provisions for body-worn operations. Due to this fact, and low output power, it is considered to comply with the FCC RF exposure requirement.
