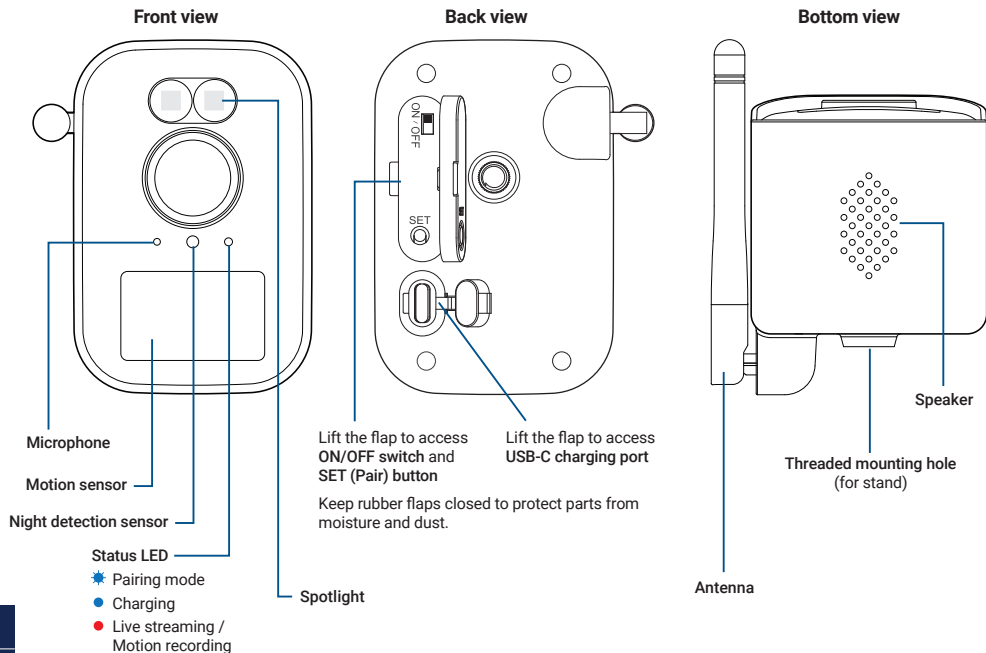

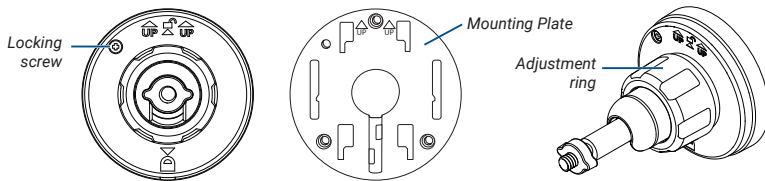
SETTING UP THE CAMERA

1 Charge the camera

The camera is shipped partially charged. For optimal performance, fully charge it with the included USB-C cable before first use. The LED indicator on the front of the camera lights solid blue during charging and turns off once fully charged. Charging times may vary based on the USB power source and battery level.

2 Mount the camera

The camera can sit on a table or shelf, or be wall-mounted using the included stand. Its wire-free design offers flexible placement. To install the stand, loosen the locking screw and slide up to remove the mounting plate. Secure the mounting plate to the wall with the UP arrow pointing up, then slide the stand back onto the plate and tighten the locking screw. Attach the camera and adjust the viewing angle by loosening the adjustment ring.



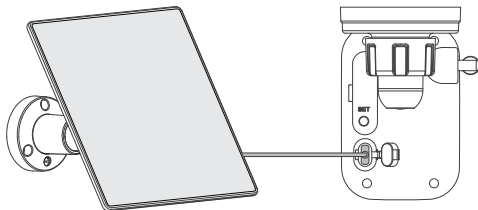
TIPS

Optimizing motion detection

- The camera's passive infrared (PIR) motion sensor is designed to detect heat signatures from moving objects. For optimal detection, position the camera at a slight downward angle to minimize sky visibility and avoid pointing it directly at trees or bushes.
- The camera is most effective when objects move across its field of view. Angle it to capture side-to-side movement rather than movement toward or away from the camera. This setup helps minimize false triggers and increases the likelihood of capturing important activity.
- If you're getting too many false alerts, try lowering the motion detection sensitivity. Keep in mind that higher sensitivity increases battery usage. You can also set up specific motion detection zones to focus on areas of interest and reduce unnecessary alerts.

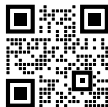
Solar Panel Charging

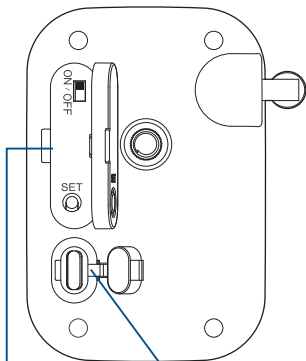

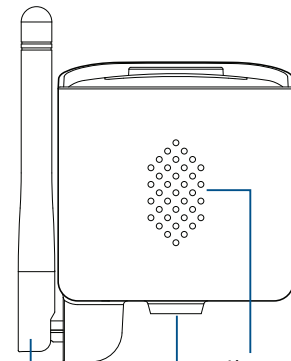

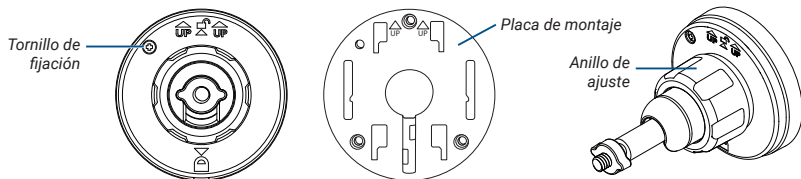
CONFIGURACIÓN DE LA CÁMARA

1 Cargar la cámara:

La cámara se envía parcialmente cargada. Para un rendimiento óptimo, cárguela completamente con el cable USB-C incluido antes de usarla. El indicador LED en el frente de la cámara se ilumina en azul fijo mientras se carga y se apaga cuando la carga está completa. El tiempo de carga varía según la fuente de alimentación USB y el nivel de batería restante.

2 Montar la cámara:

La cámara puede colocarse sobre una mesa o estante, o montarse en la pared utilizando el soporte incluido. Su diseño sin cables permite una instalación flexible. Para instalar el soporte, afloje el tornillo de fijación y deslícelo hacia arriba para retirar la placa de montaje. Fije la placa a la pared asegurándose de que la flecha "UP" apunte hacia arriba. Luego, deslice el soporte nuevamente sobre la placa y apriete el tornillo de fijación. Coloque la cámara y ajuste el ángulo de visión aflojando el anillo de ajuste.



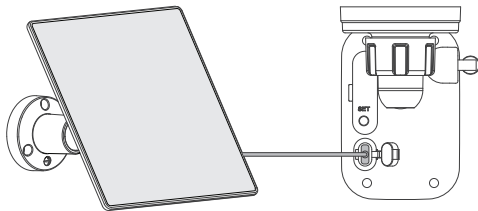
CONSEJOS

Optimización de la detección de movimiento

- El sensor de movimiento pasivo infrarrojo (PIR) de la cámara está diseñado para detectar firmas de calor de objetos en movimiento. Para una detección óptima, oriente la cámara ligeramente hacia abajo para minimizar la visibilidad del cielo y evite apuntarla directamente a árboles o arbustos.
- La cámara funciona mejor cuando los objetos se mueven a través del campo de visión. Inclínala para capturar movimiento de lado a lado en lugar de movimiento directo hacia o desde la cámara. Esto ayuda a reducir falsas alertas y mejora la posibilidad de captar eventos importantes.
- Si está recibiendo muchas alertas falsas, intente reducir la sensibilidad del sensor de movimiento. Tenga en cuenta que una sensibilidad más alta consume más batería. También puede configurar zonas específicas de detección para enfocar áreas de interés y evitar alertas innecesarias.

Carga mediante panel solar

- ¿Usa la cámara en exteriores? Conéctela a un panel solar compatible de Swann para una carga continua.
- Aproveche la energía solar diaria para mantener su cámara encendida sin interrupciones.
