Ericsson AB is submitting an application for Class II Permissive Change to our Mini-PCIe wireless WAN card, Model C5621 (FCC ID: VV7-MBMC5621-D1).

Description of Changes:

1. The product VV7-MBMC5621-D1 will be installed in the following model of tablet: Dell Latitude 10 – ST2
2. The antenna connected to the FCC ID: VV7-MBMC5621-D1 is located in the display of the tablet and has a gain of less than 1.01 dBi in the low bands and 1.91 dBi in the high bands. More details about the antenna position and the gain and type of antennas can be found in the operational description.
3. The above mentioned tablet may have the following co-located transmitters installed. DWM-W091 – FCC ID: EW4DWMW091
4. The above mentioned tablet utilizes proximity sensor functionality to enable the power to be dynamically reduced for human exposure purposes when the laptop comes into proximity of a human body.
5. Dell and the tablet Model: Dell Latitude 10 – ST2 implements a 2-Way Authentication as per documentation submitted with this application, to allow end user installation of the module.
