RE: Modular Approval Request for UCF VM 8x9, FCC ID: VXY 70002

Dear Sir,

With regards to our application for equipment authorization of the UCF VM 8x9, FCC ID: VXY 70002 listed below are the modular approval requirements with which the EUT complies:

1. The modular transmitter has its own RF shielding.
2. The modular transmitter has buffered data inputs/outputs.
3. The modular transmitter has its own power supply regulator.
4. The antenna is an integral printed circuit and cannot be changed by the user.
5. The modular transmitter was tested in a stand alone configuration, i.e., outside of the host SVM-7-1 and complies with the AC line conducted requirements.
6. The modular transmitter will be labeled with its own FCC ID. Also, the OEM host will be informed to display a label referring to the enclosed module "Contains FCC ID: VXY 70002"
7. The modular transmitter complies with §15.247. Installation and other requirements are presented in the user's guide to allow the unit to be installed correctly.
8. The modular transmitter complies with the RF exposure requirements as specified in §15.247 (refer to MPE calculation exhibit).
