If this product will be used by young children, this manual should be read and explained to them by an adult. The GoLive2™ STIX™ is not recommended for children under 6 years of age.

GoLive2™ STIX™ meets or exceeds U.S.A. Voluntary Product Safety Standards ASTM F963 and all Canadian Safety Regulations.

! WARNING: Repetitive Motion Injuries and Eyestrain

Playing video games can make your muscles, joints, skin or eyes hurt. Follow these instructions to avoid problems such as tendonitis, carpal tunnel syndrome, skin irritation or eyestrain:

- Avoid excessive play.
- Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour.
- If any part of your body becomes tired or sore while playing, or if you feel symptoms such as tingling, numbness, burning or stiffness, stop and rest for several hours before playing again.
- If you continue to have symptoms or feel any discomfort during or after play, stop playing and see a doctor.

! WARNING: Motion Sickness

Playing video games may cause motion sickness in some players. If you feel dizzy or nauseous stop playing and rest. Do not drive or engage in other activities until you feel better.

! WARNING: Electric Shock

To avoid electric shock when using this product do not use the STIX™ during a lightning storm. There may be a risk of electric shock from lightning.

! WARNING: Seizures

Some people may have seizures or blackouts triggered by light flashes or patterns, and this may occur while they are watching TV or playing video games, even if they have never had a seizure before.

Anyone who has had a seizure, loss of awareness, or any other symptom linked to an epileptic condition should consult a doctor before playing video games.

Stop playing and consult a doctor if you have any of the following symptoms:

Convulsions	Eye or muscle twitching
Loss of awareness	Altered vision
Involuntary movements	Disorientation

To reduce the likelihood of a seizure while playing video games:

- Sit or stand as far from the screen as possible.
- Do not play if you are tired or sleep deprived.
- Play in a well-lit room.
- Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour.

Although the GoLive2™ STIX™ does not contribute to any additional risks, it is recommended that an adult always supervise children when playing with this product. If the adult supervising notices the child experiencing dizziness, altered vision, confusion, or convulsions, stop the child from playing and seek a doctor's care immediately.

! WARNING: Radio Frequency Interference

The STIX™ can emit radio waves that can affect the operation of nearby electronics, including cardiac pacemakers.

- Do not operate the STIX™ within 9 inches of a pacemaker.
- If you have a pacemaker or other implanted medical device, do not use the STIX™ without first consulting a doctor or the manufacturer of your medical device.

Installing Batteries

! CAUTION: Batteries should be installed by an adult.

Items Needed

- Two (2) (Four (4) Optional) AA (1.5V) Heavy Duty (Carbon Zinc) batteries (included)
- Phillips screwdriver (not included)
- GoLive2™ STIX™ Controller


! CAUTION: Batteries may be harmful if swallowed.

Attention: Important Battery Information

- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Always have an adult change the batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix standard (Carbon Zinc), alkaline, or rechargeable batteries within the same battery compartment.
- Be sure to insert the batteries matching the positive (+) and negative (-) polarity indicated inside the battery compartment.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Dispose of batteries properly. Do not throw batteries into the fire.
- Remove exhausted or drained batteries at once from the controller.
- Replace the batteries if the LED lights become dim or weak.
- Replace with new batteries at the first sign of erratic operation.
- Replace all batteries of the same type/brand at the same time.
- Remove batteries if the STIX™ Controller is not going to be used for some time.
- Keep batteries out of reach of small children—batteries may be harmful if swallowed and could pose a choking hazard.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the STIX™ Controller before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

To install batteries into your STIX™ Controller:

1. Using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen and remove the battery cover screw.




- Remember to turn the screwdriver left to loosen the screw, right to tighten the screw.


Remove the battery cover, and the batteries, if needed.


STIX™ Controller – Front View




STIX™ Controller – Back View




STIX™ Base – Front View

If you are younger than 14 years of age you will need to provide a parent(s) or guardian(s) email address to register.


2. Carefully read the Terms of Service. If you agree to these terms and conditions, click the "I Agree" check box.

If you are younger than 14 years of age, you must review the information with your parent(s) or guardian(s).


3. Click the Register button to complete registration.

Installing Batteries

2. Insert two (2) new AA (1.5V) batteries into the appropriate slots. Make sure to match the positive (+) and negative (-) polarity, as indicated inside the battery compartment.




3. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw in place by turning the screwdriver to the right. Do not use too much force or over-tighten, as this can strip the screw and damage the battery cover.



4. Turn ON your STIX™ Controller by pressing the power button located on the top of the STIX™ Controller.

The LED lights will shine when the STIX™ Controller is on.

NOTE: The STIX™ Controller will go into sleep mode after 10 minutes of inactivity. When this happens, push the power button or the B button to wake the STIX™.



Tip!

If your STIX™ Controller does not turn on when batteries are installed, check the following:

- Batteries are installed in the correct polarity in the battery compartment.
- Batteries hold a charge sufficient for operation.

CAUTION: Battery Leakage

Leakage of battery acid can cause personal injury as well as damage to your STIX™. If battery leakage occurs, thoroughly wash the affected skin and clothes. Keep battery acid away from eyes and mouth. Leaking batteries may make popping sounds. To avoid battery leakage, refer to the important battery information section on page 8.

Installing GoLive2™ STIX™ Software on Your PC

Before you download the GoLive2™ STIX™ Software to your PC, you need to check the minimum system requirements on page 10.

The GoLive2™ Welcome page displays the when you connect the STIX™ Base to your PC.

1. Click the **Download Now!** button on the GoLive2™ Web site.
 - A prompt to Run or Save the software to your computer appears.
2. Click the **Run** button to start the installer. Once you have read and agreed to the user agreement, the installer begins to load the software onto your PC and an installation progress bar will appear. Upon completion, you will be prompted to launch the software.



An icon appears on your PC's desktop once the GoLive2™ STIX™ Software is loaded on your computer.

Minimum Supported System


- PC: Windows 2000, Flash 8 or above

- Windows: Internet Explorer 6, Firefox 1.0
- Monitor Resolution: 1024 x 768
