## Bluetooth Headset

The Bluetooth Headset is a Bluetooth device developed with the latest technology, which can connect to other Bluetooth devices such as mobile phone, desktop or notebook computer, PDA wirelessly within a range of 10 meters.

## Getting Start

### Charing battery

The Headset comes with an embedded rechargeable battery. For first time use, it takes about 2 hours to fully charge. With battery fully charge, the talk time is about 5 hours, and the stand-by time will be about 150 hours.

1. Connect Travel Charge with AC power, the green indicator of charge will light up.
2. Connect the Charge DC Jack Connector and Headset as picture shown above, red indicators of Connector will light up.
3. When tha battery is full charged, the red indicator of Connector will be off.

### Turning On/Off Headset

1. To turn on the Headset ,press and hold on/off button for 5 seconds. You will hear one long high tones and the blue indicator of Headset flashes.
2. To turn off the Headset,press and hold on/off button for 5 seconds. You will hear one long low tones and the red indicator flashes quickly. Then the Headset is powered off.
3. The red indicator of Headset will flash slowly when the battery low.

### Paring Headset

You are required to pair the Headset with your mobile phone or other devices before using it.

Step 1: The Headset must be powered off before initiating pairing. To initiate pairing, press and hold On/Off button for 7 seconds until the blue and red indicators of Headset are flashing alternatively. If you are wearing the Headset during the pairing process ,you will hear two short high tones when the Headset is ready for pairing.

Step 2: Initiate pairing process of your mobile phone. Refer to the manual of mobile phone for detail process. You will see a new item added in your Bluetooth device list after searching process.

Step 3: You will be asked to complete pairing, ente 0000 and confirm it. The red indicator of Headset will turn off and the blue indicator will flash after pairing completed successfully.

## Making Calls

You are able to use the Headset to make calls when it is paired successfully

with your mobile phone.

1. Using voice dialing—Press On/Off button, waiting for a beep and say the name of the person you want to call. Press On/Off button again to cancel voice dialing.
2. Using phone keys—Dial the number on the mobile phone as you usually do. Once the call has been set up, the voice will be transmitted to Headset automatically.
3. Redial—Press and hold “+” buttons for 3 seconds to redial the last number you called.

### **Answering/Ending Calls**

1. When the Headset is powered on and the mobile phone rings, you will hear a musical tone and the blue indicator will change to be quick flashing . Press On/Off button to answer the call.
2. Press and hold ON/OFF button for 3 seconds to reject the call.
3. If the Headset is powered off, press and hold ON/OFF button for 3 seconds to turn it on and answer the call.
4. Adjust Headset volume by pressing “+” button for volume up and pressing “—“ button for volume down.
- 5 .End calls by pressing ON/OFF button for 1 seconds or do nothing.

### **Transfer/Switch Calls**

Press and hold ON/OFF button for 3 seconds to transfer the call to mobile phone while talking on the Headset . if you want to transfer the call back to Headset, press ON/OFF button again ,or press ON/OFF button 1 second.

### **Mute**

Press S3 buttons in the same time for a Mute function. Press “+” or “-“ button 1 Second to disable the Mute function.
