On behalf of Fountain People, Professional Testing (EMI), Inc. is seeking a limited modular approval for the Wireless Activator transmitter. Requirements listed in 47 CFR Part 15.212 are addressed below.

- 1) The EUT does not have shielding over the RF portion of the device. The EUT will never be integrated with other electronics. It will only be placed in various enclosure types to sense a vibration or shock event.
- 2) The EUT will never be connected electrically to another device therefore it does not need buffered data or modulation inputs.
- 3) The module is powered via an onboard battery.
- 4) The antenna requirement is satisfied by the use of an integrated antenna on the PCB.
- 5) The module was tested in a standalone configuration in which it will be used.
- 6) A sticker is affixed to the back side of the EUT. The device will only be incorporated into a enclosure so that it can sense the vibration from that enclosure. The enclosure will have the FCC ID of the device shown.
- 7) The Users Manual explains that any modifications may strictly void the certification and a separate approval must be obtained.
- 8) Emissions are far below the RF Exposure limits, no exhibit attached.
