





Avantree Voyager Quick Start Guide



Step 1: Power On and Put the Voyager into Pairing Mode



Slide the  switch of the Voyager to  position (The button silk print may vary by batches, either  or "ON"). For first time use, the Voyager will enter PAIRING mode automatically. For subsequent use, put your Voyager into PAIRING mode by pressing & holding the  button until the screen displays "Put device in Pairing mode...Disconnect from Phone....."

Step 2: Put Your Bluetooth Headphones into PAIRING Mode

Note: Simply turning on the headphones does not always activate pairing mode. Ensure your device is in pairing mode, typically indicated by an LED flashing alternately red and blue. For more details, please refer to your device's online user manual.

Step 3: Connect Your Headphones to the Voyager

Press the **+** / **-** button to select your device, then press the  button once to connect it. The indicator  shown to the right of the device name indicates a successful connection.



You can disconnect the device by double clicking the  button, and put the Voyager into PAIRING mode again by pressing and holding the  button to connect it with another device.

Step 4: Connecting to an Audio Source

Connect the Voyager to an in-flight entertainment system or any AUX 3.5mm audio source. If you're using an older aircraft system, the Dual 3.5mm Male to 3.5mm Female adapter may be required.

Auracast Broadcasting Setup

To use Auracast broadcasting, all connected devices must support Auracast.

Step 1: Slide the  switch of the Voyager to  position.

Step 2: Activate Auracast Mode on your device. Connection steps may vary depending on the brand. Please refer to the user manual of your device for detailed instructions or contact us for help.
