

# TWS Earbuds (ANC+ENC) 4 Mic

## User Manual

### Paring

#### 1: Auto Pairing

Opening the charging case and take earphones out, and then the earphones will automatically turn on and pair. Open up earbuds setting on your smart device and scan for earbuds model name .

# Operation

## **1: Power on/off .**

1. Open the charging case and take out earphones, automatically turn on;  
Place earphones into charging case and close the case, automatically turn off.

## **2: Play/Pause music.**

When listening to music. tap the left/right earphones twice to play or pause the music.

## **3: Volume -/+**

When listening to music.

Tap left earphones once to decrease the volume

Tap right earphones once to increase the volume

## **4: Previous /Next Song**

Tap left earphones three times to previous song.

Tap right earphones three times to next song.

## **5: Answer/Hang up**

When there is an incoming call.

Tap left or right earphones once to answer the call.

Tap left or right earphones again to end the call.

## **5: Reject**

When there is an incoming call.

Long press left or right earphones for 3 seconds to reject the call.

## **6:Voice assistant**

Long press left earphones for 2 seconds to activate voice assistant.

## **6: Noise reduction mode**

Long press right earphones for 2 seconds to Transparent mode, ANC ON, ANC OFF.

# Charging Function

Fully charge the case and earphones before using for the first time.

## **1: Charging the charging case**

There is a Type-C cable included in the packaging. Connect it to the Type-C charging port and the other end into a USB powered source to charge your case.

## 2: Earphone charging

When battery is low, each 5s flash once for left and right side red light at the same time, you will listen to a warning sign or tone. It will turn off when the earphones completely out of battery.

(a) Place the earphones into the charging case.

(b) red light on the earphones turn on when charging has begun. The light will turn off when charging is complete.
