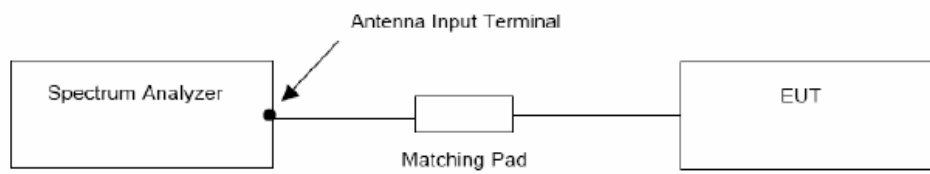

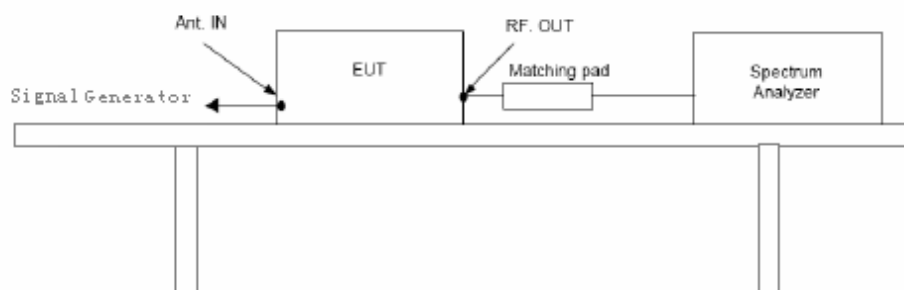


### ***Radiated Emission Measurement Set up***

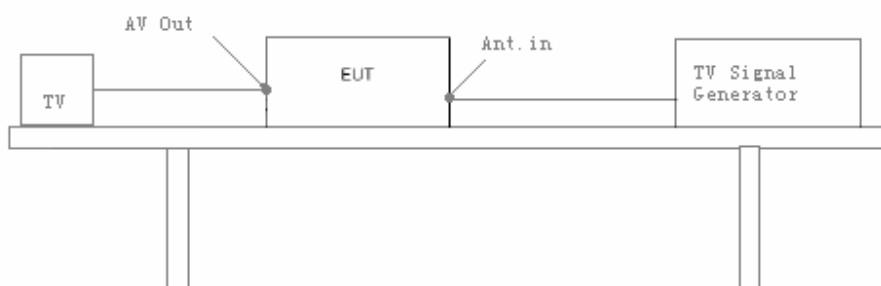




### ***Antenna Power Conduction Measurement Set up***

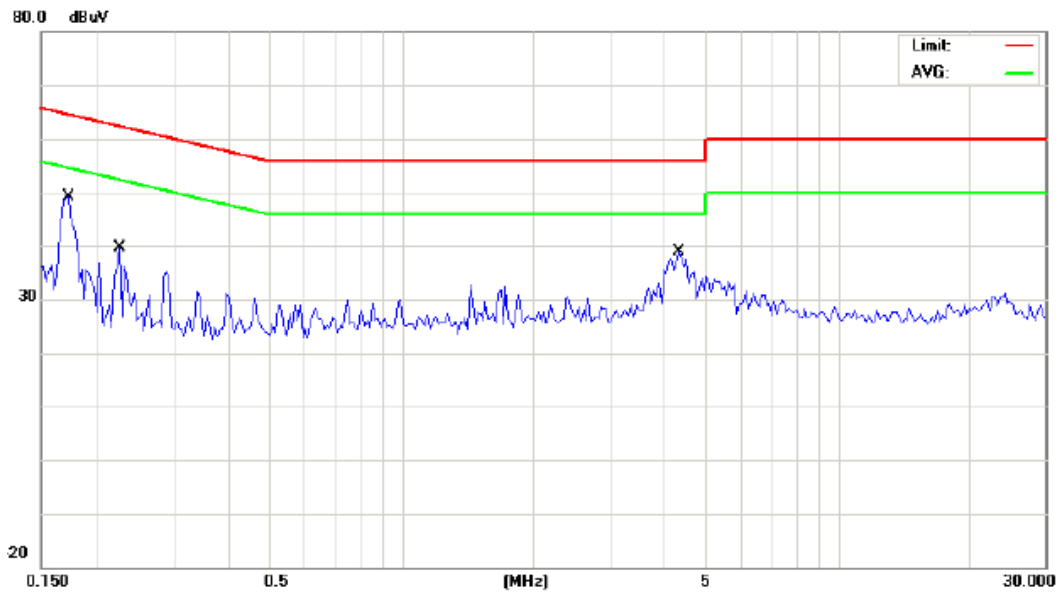
*Line L Conducted Emission Graph(AV Output)*




