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1 General Information

1.1 General Description

The equipment under test (EUT) is a toy for Deluxe Fuel Cell. The oscillation of MCU is generated by an 8MHz and a 32.768kHz crystals. The EUT is powered by 3 x 1.5V AAA size batteries. There are three buttons on the EUT. When the button is pressed, the EUT will release sound and turn on the LED. The EUT can also be connected to a computer. When the EUT is connected to a computer, we can update the program.

The brief circuit description is listed as follows:

- U1, Y1, Y2 and associated circuit act as a controller.
- U2 and associated circuit act as a voltage regulator.
- U3 and associated circuit act as a ROM.
- U4 and associated circuit act as a sound driver.

2 Description of the radiated emission test

2.1 Test Procedure

Radiated emissions measurements are investigated and taken pursuant to the procedures of ANSI C63.4 – 2003.

The equipment under test (EUT) was placed on a non-conductive turntable with dimensions of 1.5m x 1m and 0.8m high above the ground. 3m from the EUT, a broadband antenna mounting on the mast received the signal strength. The turntable was rotated to maximize the emission level. The antenna was then moving along the mast from 1m up to 4m until no more higher value was found. Both horizontal and vertical polarization of the antenna were placed and investigated.

For below 30MHz, a loop antenna with its vertical plane is placed 3m from the EUT and rotated about its vertical axis for maximum response at each azimuth about the EUT. And the centre of the loop shall be 1 m above the ground.

The device was rotated through three orthogonal to determine which attitude and configuration produce the highest emission during measurement for radiated emission measurement.

2.2 Test Result

The emissions from 30MHz to 1000MHz were investigated. The highest emissions were presented in next page.

Emissions with more than 20dB below the limit were not reported in next page.

The emissions meeting the requirement of section 15.109 are based on measurements employing the CISPR quasi-peak detector below 1000MHz and average detector for frequencies above 1000MHz.

It was found that the EUT meet the FCC requirement.
