Using mobile phone while driving may distract the driver's attention, thereby increasing the possibility of accidents.

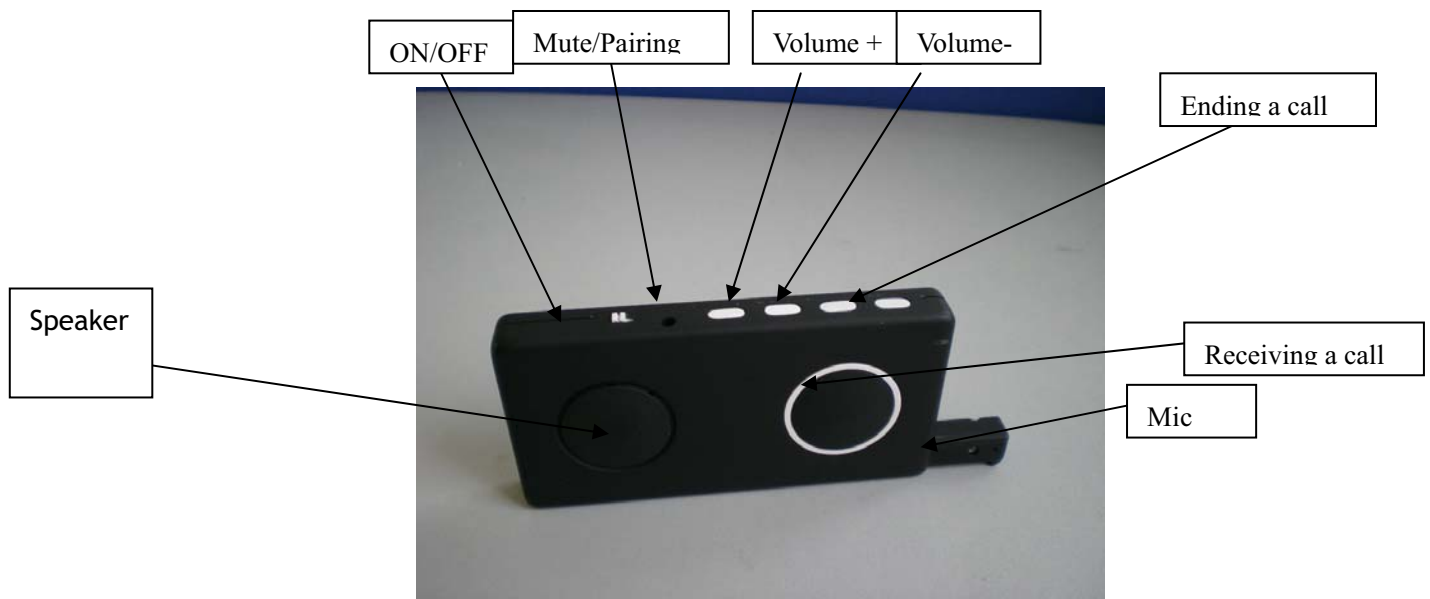





## Function Table of Keys



Symbol	Name	Function
	On/Off	<p>① On</p> <p>Press “On/Off” key on the right, then the sound of “DU” is heard. The LED flickers, the device is on now.</p> <p>② Off</p>



		<p>Press “On/Off” key on the left, then the sound of “DU” is heard. The LED is off, the device is off now.</p>
	<p>Pairing/Mute</p>	<p>① Enter into mute mode.</p> <p>Ensure that the device is on first, Press “Pairing/ Mute” for about two seconds until the sound of “DI-DU, DU” is heard. The LED flickers quickly and the mirror displays “ENTER PAIRING”, the device enters into pairing mode. Activate Bluetooth function of the mobile phone. (Refer to the mobile phone’s User Guide for details). A list of enabled devices in range will show after the process of “search “is finished. Select “DR01A” from the list on the mobile phone, enter the password “8888” to confirm the pairing process. Ensure that the “DR01A” has stored in the mobile phone. The step of “Pairing” is successful when the speed of LED light</p>

		your mobile phone, the red LED flickers, then press the “Ending a call” key. Once you hear a beep of voice dialing, speak the stored name and the corresponding stored number will be dialed.
	Volume +	Increase the volume  If the speaker’s volume is turned too high, the ticking will be heard.
	Volume -	Decrease the volume  If the speaker’s volume is turned too low, the ticking will be heard.

**Note: Before using the device, you must pair the device with the Bluetooth of mobile phone at first.**

**1** You have about three minutes to finish the pairing process when the car kit enters into the pairing mode every time. The pairing will finish and enter into standby mode automatically (The red LED is off and the green LED is on.), when the time is over. Then, repeat the process of “Off”-“On” - “Pairing/Connection” again. Connection will be saved once paired. Device will connect to the mobile phone automatically after pressing “On/Off” key. (Some mobile phones must be opened the Bluetooth enhancement function first and then paired .)



**2** The car kit will disconnect with your mobile phone automatically without a maximum range of 10 meters. Please press the “Receiving a call” key to reconnect the car kit to your mobile phone when your mobile phone has been brought back within the working range again.

**3** “Last number redialing” and “Voice Commands” depend on the mobile phones. Some mobile phones don’t support this function. Please refer to the User Guide of your mobile phone. Ensure that a voice tag has been stored in the mobile phone before using “Voice Commands”.

**4** The car kit is only used with the mobile phones which have standard Bluetooth function. Some mobile phones without Bluetooth function or smuggled goods cannot pair with the car kit.

**5 Charging:** That the device beeps every 30 sec. while standby or during the conversation indicates that batteries need charging. Please use the provided charger to charge the device. The red LED is on during charging. After charged, the red LED is off and the green LED is on. Full charging period is about 4 hours (depending on the capacity of the battery).
