### 4. Pair your iWallet™ to your phone (optional)

To activate the Bluetooth features of your iWallet™, it must be paired with your phone.



### Getting Started

#### 1. Charge your iWallet™

Make sure that your iWallet™ is fully charged before you start using it. Use the included USB cable to charge directly from your PC. When the LED light (e1) is solid red, your iWallet™ is charging. When the LED light (e1) is green, it is fully charged.

#### 2. Install iWallet™ PC Application

Insert the included mini CD into your computer CD drive. Follow the onscreen prompts to install the iWallet™ PC application.

#### 3. Enroll your fingerprints to iWallet™

Launch the iWallet™ application to begin enrolling your fingers.


- Enter your password.



Note: The default password is 1234. We recommend you to change your password for your own protection.

### 6. Using your iWallet™

Once fingerprint enrollment and Bluetooth pairing (optional) is done, you can start using your iWallet™.



#### 1. To open your iWallet™

- Press the biometric button (b) to turn on unit. The LED green light will turn on.
- Swipe registered finger on fingerprint sensor (d). You will have 5 seconds for swiping your finger before the fingerprint sensor automatically turns off.
- As the fingerprint sensor turns off, you will hear an audible beep. If you did not have time to swipe your finger before it turns off, repeat steps (a) and (b).

- Once you have accessed your belongings, simply close the iWallet™ until it locks in place.

#### 2. To enable Bluetooth feature on your iWallet™

- Press and hold the Bluetooth (a) button for 3 seconds to turn on Bluetooth.
- If your iWallet™ is already paired with your phone, then the link will automatically be established.

CAUTION: Your cellular phone must be always on in order to use the alarm alert feature.

#### 3. To disable Bluetooth feature

- Press and hold the Bluetooth button (a) for 3 seconds to turn it off.

#### Technical Specifications

On a fully charged iWallet™, the battery duration time is up to approximately 24-48 hours

Rechargeable battery with charging option from AC power supply (sold separately), PC via USB cable or car charger (sold separately)

Bluetooth operating range up to 30 feet (10 meters)

### Start the Pairing

Place your iWallet™ and mobile phone at a close range:

Instructions	LED Status
To put the iWallet into Pairing mode	Green LED and Red LED
1. Press and hold the Bluetooth button (a) for three seconds while the wallet is off, and keep pressing it for three more seconds until you hear a beep.	Red LED
2. The iWallet will go into Pairing mode.	Blue LED
You will have five minutes to set up the wireless connection between the iWallet and mobile phones.	Blue LED

Note: The PIN Code for iWallet is 1234

### 5. What the LED lights mean

Operational State	Left LED	Middle LED	Right LED
When Bluetooth is on	Blinks Slowly		
Pairing	Blinks		
Connected to phone	Solid light		
Standby	Blinks Slowly		
Fingerprint Sensor is activated		Green LED blinks	
Fully charged		Green LED blinks	Red light blinks
