
***Re: Change in FCC ID for Telit GSM Module GE865-QUAD; New FCC ID: X6K-TEL-001***

To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of Blackbird Technologies, Inc. ("Blackbird"), I am writing to provide the following information in connection with Blackbird's FCC certification request for its Panther™ device (the "Product"). The Product incorporates previously certified equipment, specifically, the Telit GSM Module GE865-QUAD (the "GSM Module"). The original FCC ID on the GSM Module is RI7GE865 and was originally granted on June 5, 2009, with a Class II permissive change approved on September 20, 2010. Blackbird incorporated the GSM Module without modification into the Product. Because we did not modify the GSM Module, we believe the original test results are still representative.
