The following application is submitted on behalf of our client, HomeRun Holdings, for evaluation of their models QTL184 and QTL74 for certification under FCC Part 15.231.

The Qmotion remote transmitter is a handheld, battery operated remote control designed to operate an electronic window shade(s). There are two model versions of the Qmotion remote; the QTL184 and the QTL74. The two models are electrically identical and differ only in the number of buttons displayed on the front enclosure. The QTL184 has 3 rows of 18 buttons, while the QTL74 has 2 rows of 12 buttons.

The two model versions are electrically identical; therefore only model QTL184 was evaluated. The device was tested in three orientations which represents normal intended operation. The device was tested in full to the requirements of the aforementioned rules and was found to be in compliance.
