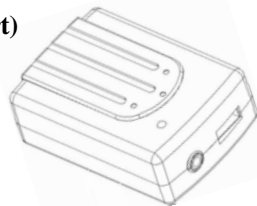

based on wireless Bluetooth technology. You can easily enjoy high quality music without the limitations and inconvenience from the wired lines.

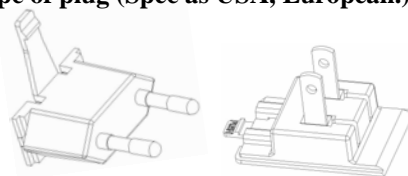

B. Features & Function

1. Connecting with the speakers first when using BT Music Receiver,.
2. When playing music in your cell-phones or computers through the Speakers based on BT Music Receiver, you Need not connect cell-phones or computers with the

speakers.

3. HY-MP is the software symbol of BT Music Receiver, If your mobile phones or computers detected this symbol, it means you established a wireless connection with the speakers.
4. USB port in BT Music Receiver can be used to charge for other electronic products.

C. Operation & Setting

1. To plug the BT Music Receiver in outlet, make sure the power is on work. Different Plugs available for different standards.
2. To connect BT Music Receiver with the speakers. The indicating light on and flashing, It shows Bluetooth

is active and waiting.

3. To active the Bluetooth function in the cell-phones or computers for sourcing HY-MP symbol and pairing, connecting.
4. To input the password 0000, connecting with HY-MP, then press ENTER to complete the connection, meanwhile the indicating light will be always on.
5. By phone or computer operating Play Options, speakers will receive instructions accordingly.
6. Music will be automatically stopped playing when phone calls coming, and play again if calls end.

D. Special Notes

1. Make sure the Bluetooth function is active in cell-phones or computers.
2. If pairing or connecting failed, to disconnect the power on BT Music Receiver, and reset again.
