Description of the different configurations

ISO-6101

This unit is the most basic of the series. The ISO-6101 unit has a detachable reader box and no batteries.

ISO-6101BT

The ISO-6101BT unit has a detachable reader box with Bluetooth module fitted(pre-approved) and no batteries.

ISO-6101EXP

The ISO-6101EXP unit has a detachable reader box with 9000 expansion Board fitted and no batteries.

ISO-6101HM-EXP

The ISO-6101HM-EXP unit has a hard mounted reader box with 9000 expansion Board fitted and no batteries.

ISO-6101HM-EXP-CLK

The ISO-6101HM-EXP-CLK unit has a hard mounted reader box with 9000 expansion Board and master clock fitted and no batteries.

ISO-6102

The ISO-6102 unit has a detachable reader box and batteries fitted.

ISO-6102BT

The ISO-6102BT unit has a detachable reader box with Bluetooth module fitted(pre-approved) and batteries fitted.

ISO-6102EXP
