## 1 **Notice Before Using**


Thank you for purchasing the Celltronix Bluetooth Headset VR1. Please check the contents of this package to verify the items listed below have been included in your package. Please read this User's Manual completely before you use the Headset. The VR1 has been developed using Bluetooth wireless technology and is capable of connecting with Bluetooth devices designed with Audio Gateway. PDAs, Desktop and Notebook computers can be connected and paired with the Headset using a USB Bluetooth Dongle. Before using the Headset please verify your Bluetooth device (Phone, PDA) complies with Bluetooth V1.1/V1.2/V2.0/V2.1 and supports the Bluetooth Headset or Hands-free profile.

### 3 VR1 Recordable Bluetooth Headset Overview

## 4 *Charging the battery*

This headset has an internal, non-removable, rechargeable battery. Do not attempt to remove the battery from the device as you may damage the device. Please refer to the following steps to charge the battery:

1. Connect the charger to the correct outlet.
2. When the charger is connected to the headset, the red indicator light will turn on indicating it is charging. If charging does not start, disconnect the charger, plug it in again. Charging the battery fully may take up to 2 hours.
3. When the battery is fully charged, the red indicator light will turn off. Disconnect the charger from the headset and the wall outlet. The headset is ready to use.

### **NOTE:**

- The fully charged battery has power for up to 10 hours of talk-time or up to 400 hours of standby time. However, the talk and standby times may vary when used with different mobile phones or other compatible Bluetooth devices, usage settings, usage styles, and environments.
- When the battery power is low, the headset will remind you by beeps every 20 seconds, and the red indicator light starts to flash.
- For first time use, please charge the headset fully. If you can not see the indicator light while charging, please leave the headset on the charger for a while, and then the indicator light will turn on.

## 5 Recording Information

- 8 minutes total recording time
- Unlimited recording until memory is full
- Press the **Play** button to move to the next recorded message
- Record incoming calls or record personal memos
- "Full Memory" audio indication

## 6 How to Record and Playback Messages

### \* Record

1. Hold **Record** button for 1 second and you will hear a "beep" sound.
2. Release button and recording starts.
3. End the recording by pressing the **REC** button for 1 second and you will hear a "Double Beep" sound indicating that recording has ended.
4. If the memory is full, there would be a "Multiple Beeping" sound.

### \* Play

1. Press **Play** button to play the newest recording.
2. Press again to play next recording.
3. Recording can **NOT** be played during a call

### \* Delete

1. While playing a recording, hold **Play** button for 1 second until you hear a "Beeping" sound indicating the recording has been deleted.
2. To delete all recordings at once, hold **Play** button for 3 seconds until you hear multiple beeps.

## 7 Pair to your Bluetooth phone


Before you use your headset the first time, you must pair the unit with a Bluetooth enabled mobile phone.

Please refer to the following steps to set up the pairing:

Insure the headset is off.


Press and hold the **On/Off** Pairing Button on the end of the unit for 4 seconds until you see the LED light flash blue and red alternately indicating the unit is in pairing mode.


Following your phone's instruction guide, set your Bluetooth enabled phone into search mode

Your phone will find the headset and show the device name on the screen, select the device name to confirm pairing.

Enter **PIN code as 0000** (4 zeros) and confirm to complete pairing.

**NOTE:**

- If the pairing is successful, the headset will connect to your phone automatically. You may need to confirm the connection.
- While the headset is paired with the phone and connected, the indication light will flash 2 times every 5 seconds. If it failed or did not connect to the phone, the blue indicator light will flash 1 time every 3 seconds.
- Once you pair the headset with one device or more, the Headset will automatically connect to the phone you last connected whenever you turn the headset on, but make sure your phone's Bluetooth function is active.
- The headset supports Bluetooth V2.1+EDR specifications. The simplified pairing process will make pairing your devices easy. If your mobile phone supports Bluetooth V2.1+EDR specifications, you just need to turn on both of them, and add a new Bluetooth device on your phone. The headset and your phone will find each other and connect automatically.
- The headset supports multi-point technology. To connect the headset to a 2nd Bluetooth phone, please repeat the pairing operation steps above. When you are finished pairing, turn off the headset and turn on again, the headset will connect to both phones automatically.

## 8 *Battery information*

- ◆ Your device is powered by a chargeable battery. The full performance of a new battery is achieved only after two or three complete charge and discharge cycles. The battery can be charged and discharged hundreds of times.
- ◆ Unplug the charger from the electrical plug and the device when not in use. Do not leave a fully charged battery connected to a charger, since overcharging may shorten its lifetime. If left unused, a fully charged battery will lose its charge over time. If the headset will go unused for a long time, please charge fully and turn off the headset.
- ◆ To prevent over discharge endangering the battery, you are recommended to charge the headset fully each month.

## 9 *Turning headset on /off*

### \*Turn on the headset

If the headset is turned off, press and hold the **On/Off** Button for 2 seconds until you hear a melody from low to high, the headset turns on, and the Blue indicator light will flash 3 times at the same time.

### \*Connects to the phone

1. Once your headset has been successfully paired it will connect to the phone(s) you last connected with each time it is powered on (if your phones' Bluetooth function is active.)
2. The headset supports multi-point and connects to 2 phones at the same time. In some operations, you need to distinguish the connection sequence, so we appoint the phone first connected as phone 1, the second one as phone 2.

## \*Turn off the headset



At any working state after the headset turns on, press and hold the **On/Off** Button for 4 seconds, you will hear a melody from high to low, and the Red indicator light will flash 3 times at the same time, the headset turns off.

### **NOTE**

- For power saving when the headset is not connected to any device over 1 hour, the headset will turn off automatically.

## **10** *Wearing your headset*

The headset can be worn on either the Left or Right ear. If you want to switch the headset on the other ear, please refer to the following figures to change the direction of the ear hook:



## 11 Making a call

### \* By phone's keypad

While in the stand-by state, dial the number on your phone directly to make a call.

### \* Use Voice-Dialing

- 1) While in the stand-by state, press the **Answer/End** Button shortly, you will hear a short tone from the headset, and the phone will prompt you to say the voice tag, like your friend's name. If the voice tag is identified by the phone, the related number will be dialed-out momentarily.
- 2) Make sure whether your mobile phone supports voice dial recognition. You may need to set up voice tags on your mobile phone first. If the headset is connected to 2 phones, double press the **Answer/End** button which will start the Voice-Dialing of phone 2.

### \* Last number re-dialing

Press and hold the **Volume (-)** button for 2 seconds, you will hear 2 short tones, and the last number you dialed will be re-dialed out. If the headset is connected to 2 phones, press and hold the **Volume(+)** button for 2 seconds which will start the last number re-dialing of phone 2.

### NOTE

If the headset is connected to 2 phones, when one phone has an active call, the headset will disconnect to the other phone temporarily, when you end the call the headset will re-connect it automatically.

## 12 Answering a call

When you receive an incoming call, press the **Answer/End** Button shortly to answer the incoming call; you can also answer the call on your mobile.

## 13 Reject an incoming call

When you receive an incoming call, press and hold **Answer/End** Button for 2 seconds to reject the incoming call.

## 14 Transferring a call

While on a call, press and hold the **Volume(+)**button for 2 seconds to transfer the call from headset to phone. Repeating this operation will transfer the call between the phone and headset.

## 15 Ending a call

While on a call, press the **Answer/End** Button shortly to end the call; you can also end the call on your mobile.

## 16 Call-waiting (Three-Way Calling)

Before using Call-waiting function on your headset, please ensure that your phone supports the Hands-free profile, and you have been provided the service by your carrier.

- \* If there is an incoming call while you are on a call, press the **Answer/End** Button shortly to accept the waiting call and end the current call.
- \* If there is an incoming call while you are on a call, press and hold the **Answer/End** Button for 2 seconds to accept the waiting call and put the current call on hold.
- \* While you are on a call and another call is holding, press the **Answer/End** Button shortly to end the current call and resume the call on hold.

- \* While you are on a call and another call is holding, press and hold the **Answer/End** Button for 2 seconds to shift the current call to the call on hold.
- \* While you are on a call and another call is holding, press the **Volume(+)** button shortly to add the call on hold to the current conversation to make a multi-party call.
- \* While you are on a call and another call is holding, or you are in a multi-party call, double press the **Answer/End** Button to end the call or remove yourself from the multi-party call.

## **17** *Volume control & Mute function*

While on a call, you can adjust the volume by pressing the **Volume(+)** and **Volume(-)** button or you can adjust the volume on your mobile.

## **18** *Mute*

While you are on a call, press and hold the **Volume(-)** Button for 2 seconds, you will hear a melody from low to high, then the headset's MIC will be muted, and you will hear a remindful melody every 10 seconds. Repeat this operation and when you hear the melody from high to low, the mute function is cancelled.

## 19 Safety and general information

1. Please read this User's Manual carefully and follow all instructions.
2. To avoid any damage or malfunction of the device do not drop the device from high places.
3. Keep device away from humidity, water and any other liquid. If the device is exposed to water, moisture and other liquids do not operate it to avoid any electrical shock, explosion and damage to the device or yourself.
4. Do not place or keep this device near any heat sources, such as, direct sun light, radiators, stoves or other apparatus which produce heat. It may cause an explosion, degrade the performance and/or reduce battery life.
5. Do not modify, repair or disassemble device (Especially the battery: It may cause an explosion). Doing this will void the warranty.
6. Do not place heavy objects on the device.
7. Use only supplied and approved charger.
8. Replacement or service must be done by a qualified service center or manufacturer.
9. Unplug this device when unused for long periods of time or during lightening storms.
