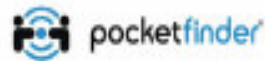
Quick Start Guide

- 1 Connect the supplied USB cable into the charging station, and the other end into a computer USB slot or wall cube charger.



- 2 Place the round PocketFinder device onto the charging station for at least 5 hours. Initially, please keep near a window with a good view of the sky.

- 3 Please have your activation code available during the account set up at <http://www.pocketfinder.com/activate>



Once at www.pocketfinder.com please follow the on screen instructions to activate your account and start locating. This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC rules, operation is subject to the following two conditions :

- 1) This device must not cause harmful interference, and
- 2) This device must accept interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

This equipment complies with FCC RF radiation exposure limits set forth for an uncontrolled environment. SAR has been evaluated as a body worn device and the maximum SAR value reported is 0.48W/Kg.

The frequency of location updates sent from the PocketFinder is variable and you can select your preferred update intervals via the web interface at www.pocketfinder.com. The location update intervals can range from one minute to several day's .

Please be aware that the one minute time interval cannot be set lower than one minute as this is defined by the PocketFinder servers.
