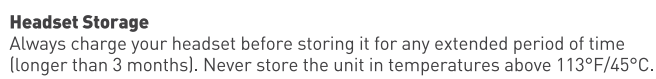

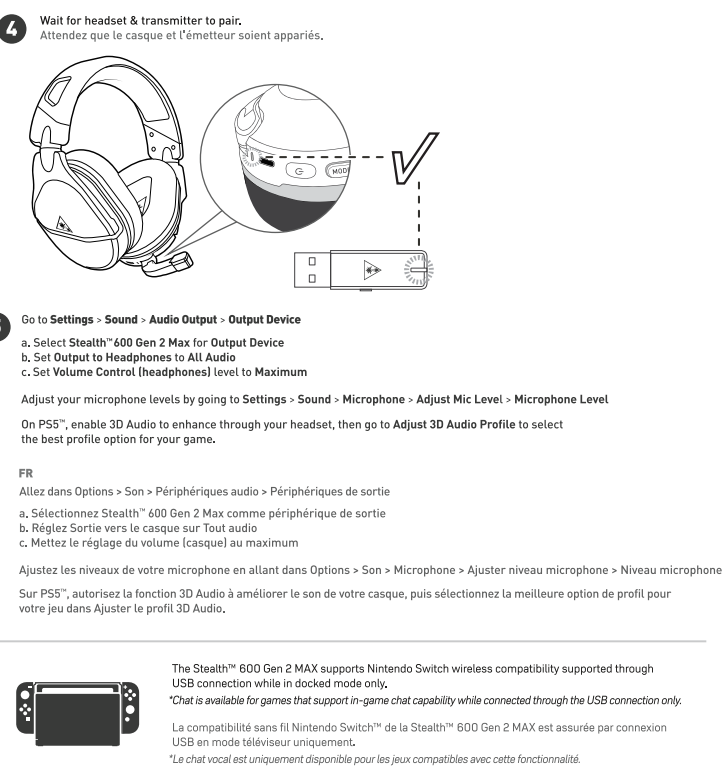

The headset and transmitter are paired out of the box, indicated by a solid LED on the wireless transmitter. If your transmitter's LED is double-blinking, follow the steps to pair your headset and wireless transmitter.

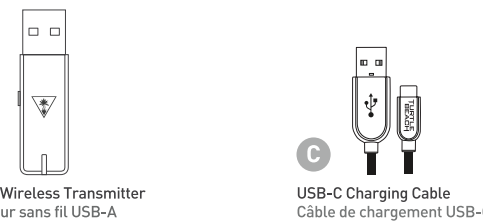

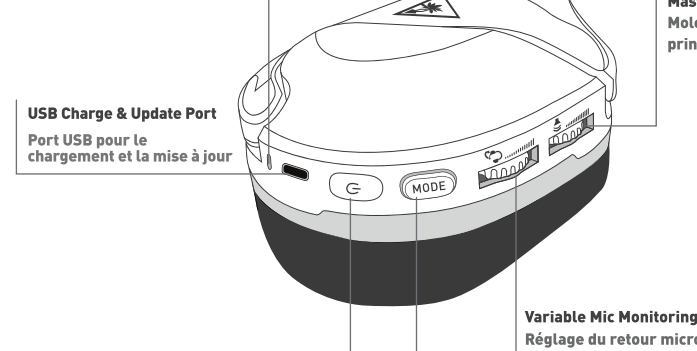

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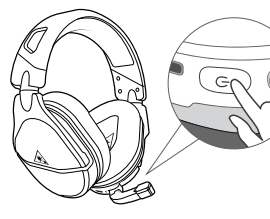

1. Remove the left ear pad by pulling the ear pad straight up using your thumb.
