To whom it may concern,

The purpose of this letter is to verify the ClearRF WRE2710 signal booster amplifier meets or exceeds the Network Protection Standards (NPS) outlined in the FCC Part 20 and KDB 935210. The WRE2710 amplifier includes additional protection features such as ClearRF's Patent Pending Passive Bypass Technology. All of these NPS and additional features are permanently enabled and cannot be reconfigured, disabled or removed.

The WRE2710 amplifier is a consumer booster and is not user programmable. The amplifier does not need fine tuning or adjustment and does not require professional installation.

The WRE2710 is not field programmable. Any future factory software upgrades will not cause non-compliance with the NPS outlined in FCC Part 20 and KDB 935210.
